BAZEL PUTMAN

of Lauderdale County Alabama

Bazel was born in 1801 in Union County, South Carolina. He was a son of Abel Putman and Milly Barnett. He was a grandson of James and Joice Putman. He moved to Tennessee right after his first marriage.

He first appears in the 1840 census of Bedford County, Tennessee with three young sons and three young daughters. At that time his first wife had died and Millie, his mom, had come to help out.

In 1850 he is in Lauderdale County, Alabama at age 50 with a new wife named Louisa who is only 30. This age should be about 42 as in later reports she is only 5-8 years younger than Bazel. In 1850 he has Samuel, Sarah, Frances, Mary, Nelly, Zedock and Nancy at home and his eldest son Abel is next door with his family.

I find him listed in 1860 in Lauderdale County, Alabama with Melinda, Nelly and Lucinda. But none of the girls' ages tie in at all. Louisa is now only 5 years younger than he.

In 1870, he is in Giles County, Tennessee at age 68, Louisa is 60, Sarah 35, Mary 33, Nancy 24, James 19 and Laura 18. Nearby are sons Samuel and Zedoc with their families.

By 1880 he is not in the Soundex. He may have died or simply not had young children at home. In 1880 most of the kids are back in Lauderdale County, Alabama again.

Based on the 1850 through 1870 census reports his children were (possibly):

Abel Putman

Abel was born April 2, 1828 in Union County, South Carolina. He married Nancy Cox, daughter of Jacob and Celia Cox, on February 8, 1849 in Lauderdale County, Alabama. I only find him in the 1860 through 1880 census of Lauderdale County. In 1900, Nancy age 72 is living with her son Jesse and his family. Abel had died February 18, 1895. In 1910 Nancy, then 82, was living with Martin Cox. I would guess Martin was a brother. Nancy died in Lexington, Lauderdale County on January 3, 1916. Their family was:

MILES RICHARD PUTMAN born June 6, 1851. He married Susan Jane Sledge on January 10, 1873. She was born July 26, 1858. He was in Lauderdale County in 1880 and 1900. Susan died April 1, 1904, and Miles remarried Anna Liles January 9, 1906. In 1910 she is called Anna, and called Indiana in 1920. They aren't in the 1930 census. The children were:

Jessie Thomas Putnam born February 15, 1874. He married Mary Elizabeth Mathews here on March 17, 1897. They are here in Green Hill through 1920 and then over in Lexington by 1930. Their children were:

William D. Putnam born July 30, 1899. He married Bernice Colbert December 26, 1920 in Lawrence County Tennessee. They are in Lauderdale County in 1930.

They had then:

Mattie Elizabeth Putnam born in 1922 and died January 12, 2007.

James Coleman Putnam born in 1924 and died in a car accident in 1940 at age 16.

Effie Mae Putnam born in 1925 and died in 2005.

Jesse Thomas Putnam born in 1927 and died October 12, 2002.

Mammie Pearl Putnam born in 1930 and died in infancy.

Maurice Putnam

Bobbie Lee Putnam born April 15, 1933 and died October 15, 1987.

Henry L. Putman born January 2, 1902. He is married to Louisa and in 1930 they are in Colbert County with a new daughter. He will die in Florence Alabama in June 1979.

Mattie C. Putman born in 1904.

Annie M. Putman born in 1908.

Nellie S. Putman born in 1912.

Cora H. Putman born in 1916.

William Richard Putman born November 23, 1876. He married Dora Lee Green in the early 1900s. They are in Lauderdale County through the 1930 census. Children until then were:

William C. Putman born in 1904 but seems to have died by 1920.

Laura A. Putman born in 1909.

Alean O. Putman born in 1910.

Willard J. Putman born in 1911.

Nellie S. Putman born in 1914.

Gladys M. Putman born in 1917.

Christine Putman born in 1878.

Andrew J. Putman born in 1881. In 1910 he is in Lauderdale County with a wife named Cora Beulah, and in Lawrence County, Tennessee in 1920 with these children, all born in Tennessee. Then they are back in Lauderdale County by 1930:

Turner Lee Putman born November 16, 1904 and died in January 1969. He married Verdie Williams in Lawrence County Tennessee June 11, 1927. In 1930 they are in Lawrence County.

Robert Haywood Putman born in 1908. He married Myrtle Erline McDonald June 22, 1927 in Lawrence County Tennessee, and in 1930 they have a son W. A. age 2 back in Lauderdale County Alabama.

Grace Belle Putman born in 1912.

Donald Gentry Putman born December 14, 1915. He is home in 1930. He died in Florence Alabama October 24, 2002.

Eva J. Putman born in 1918. She is home in 1930.

E. Marcella Putman born in Alabama in 1924.

V. L. Putman a son born in Tennessee in 1928.

James M. Putman born in 1883. In 1910 he is married to a Mary (last name probably Hendrix), and is in Wayne County, Tennessee, in Giles County in 1920 and in Smith County, Tennessee in 1930. He was a Methodist Minister. They had these children, all born in Tennessee, through 1930 based on the census reports:

E. Hendrix Putman a son born in 1922.

Frances E. Putman born in 1885.

John D. Putman born September 30, 1894. In 1920 he was in Lauderdale County and had a wife named Marsha Cora born in 1897 and one child. In 1930 they were still in Lauderdale County with more kids:

Lillian E. Putman a twin born in 1921.

Herbert S. Putman born in 1924.

Mary S. Putman born in 1928.

Lillian Putman born in 1895.

Lula E. Putman born March 3, 1896 and died October 9, 1901.

ADELINE CELIA PUTMAN born October 7, 1853. In 1900, when she was married she said it was November 1852. She married William Andrew Herman on October 23, 1871 in Alabama. They were in Hopkins County, Texas in 1900. William was born in Lexington, Lauderdale County April 13, 1849, and died in Sulphur Springs, Hopkins County, Texas on June 7, 1909. He was a Methodist minister. Adeline died there June 26, 1945. Their children were:

Julia Ann Herman born in 1872. She married Walter Rollins.

Gilbert Giles Herman born in 1875. He married Georgia Leona Thomas.

Nancy Arbanner Elizabeth Herman born January 1877.

Thomas Stephen Herman born November 1880.

Mary Loudella Herman born October 1883. She married E. F. McCormack.

Willis Cleveland Herman born May 1886. He married Dalton Ray Farler.

Florence Adeline Herman born September 1890. She married Hugh Tomlinson.

William Benjamin Herman born September 30, 1892. He married Sibyl Lorene Holly. Sibyl was an aunt of Charles Hardin 'Buddy' Holly the rock star of the 1950s. Sibyl died in 1940, and Ben married Mrs. Susie Easley Bramlett.

SARAH E. PUTMAN born May 10, 1856 and died March 18, 1858.

CHARLES PUTMAN born in 1858. He was at home in 1870 at age 11 and died by 1880.

MARY ELLIE NORA PUTMAN born October 19, 1861 and died in Lauderdale County July 24, 1952. She married Thomas J. McCafferty April 5, 1883. He was born in 1861 and died in 1940.

JACOB WYLIE PUTMAN born October 18, 1862. I do not find him in 1900, but in 1910 he is in Limestone County with his wife Mary Martina Michaels. They were married August 14, 1884. In 1910 he was 47, Mary 47 and her mother, Mary Michaels age 81, was with them. He died May 26, 1919, and in 1920 Mary is shown as a widow with only two children still at home with her. Mary died October 2, 1920. The children were:

Acie F. Putman born February 28, 1887, and died in February 1967. In 1920 and 1930 he has a wife named Belle and these children in Lauderdale County:

Gertie Putman born in 1912.

Ora Putman born September 23, 1912 and died in Lexington February 27, 1999.

H. Spencer Putman born May 31, 1914 and died in Lexington in January 1987.

Verta Putman born in 1917.

Nellie Putman born in 1919.

Juanita Putman born in 1922.

James Putman a twin born in 1924.

Eunice Putman the other twin born in 1924.

James Wilson Putman born June 13, 1889. In 1920 he has a wife named Mary R. and one child. By 1930 he has a new wife Vergie. They were married in 1928, and they have a brand new daughter.

Verly M. Putman born in 1912.

Mabel Putman born in 1930.

Lindy Putman born in 1892.

Virgil L. Putman born February 15, 1899. I don't find him in 1920, but he is married in Lexington in 1930. He will die in Lexington Alabama in January 1981. His wife Bessie Alexander and a newborn daughter Mary are there too.

Tolliver M. Putman a son born in 1893. Still at home in 1920, and married by 1930 to Susie Balch and they then have:

Zelotes Putman born in 1923.

Mary O. Putman born in 1925.

Helen Putman born in 1927.

Wiley D. Putman born in 1930.

John D. Putman born September 30, 1894. At home in 1920, and living with his brother Virgil in 1930.

SUSAN ELVA PUTMAN born in 1864.

ELIZA ANN PUTMAN born March 25, 1865, and died February 21, 1911. She married William Hardie White in Lauderdale County February 1, 1886. He was born November 13, 1864 and died in Lauderdale County November 2, 1945.

FRANCES E. PUTMAN born July 11, 1867, and died January 8, 1948. She married Stith M. Williams on September 25, 1890. He was born December 25, 1852 and died August 7, 1921.

JESSE PUTMAN born October 6, 1870 and died in Lauderdale County November 14, 1955. He married Elizabeth S. 'Lizzie' Lanier in Lauderdale County on October 26, 1891. She was born October 8, 1870 and died November 22, 1935. They were in Lauderdale County in 1900 through 1930. Their children were:

Mattie Putman born in 1893.

Clarence E. Putman born August 3, 1894. He is married to Florence here in 1930. They had then:

John W. Putman born in 1926.

Hariett L. Putman born in 1896.

Lola M. Putman born in 1898.

Gracie A. Putman born in 1902.

FRANKLIN ABEL PUTMAN born September 14 1873 and died in Lexington, Lauderdale County on October 2, 1954. He married Mace Ella Campbell in Lauderdale County on October 17, 1895. She was born February 23, 1877 and died October 4, 1929. Frank then married Georgia Lula Williams Swinea on April 27, 1932. They were divorced October 9, 1933. Frank changed his name to Frank R. Putman after Mace died, no one knows just why though. Their children were:

James Collins Putman born September 24, 1896. In 1920 and 1930 he is in Lexington and had a wife Mary Etta and:

Adolphus Elton Putman born in May 15, 1919 and died in Florence Alabama in February 1981.

Dais L. Putman a son born in 1928

Lessie Lou Putman born in April 1898.

Hartie Franklin Putman born April 25, 1900, and died in May 1974. He was a farmer with his own farm. In 1930 he was in Lexington with a wife named Clara (born January 17, 1905 and died in Lexington November 15, 1994) and these children:

Royce C. Putman born September 16, 1923 and died in Rogersville July 29, 1992.

Alvis H. Putman born May 21, 1925 and died in Lexington November 2, 2000.

Azunas C. Putman a daughter born in 1927.

Hartie Putman Jr. born in 1929.

Maude A. Putman born in 1903.

Annie M. Putman born in 1907.

Martha A. Putman born in 1910.

Manilla Putman born in 1912.

Grover Cleveland Putman born February 4, 1914 and died February 18, 1985. He married Esther Inez Davis on November 28, 1934. She was born April 27, 1911 and died November 26, 1995. They had two children: Donald Cleveland Putman and Treva Joan Putman. Don Putman visited me here at the Inn in August 2003, and supplied the info on this family.

Marie Reeda Putman born in 1917.

James Arnold Putman born January 28, 1919, and died in August 1980.

Samuel Putman

Sam was born October 6, 1832 in Tennessee. He married Mary Ann Call in Lawrence County, Tennessee on June 21, 1852. Mary Ann was born October 6, 1833 in Tennessee. He was in Giles County, Tennessee in 1870 along with his father and brother. I do not find them in either Tennessee or Alabama in 1880. In 1900 he was in Limestone County, Alabama.

In 1910, Samuel is 77 years old and living in Madison County with his eldest son Emmet Putman and that family. Samuel died in Madison County (possibly Limestone County) on September 6, 1914. There is a Mary Putman age 76 in Madison County in 1910 living or at least listed with a G. John Erwin. She *might* be Mary Ann, not certain. Mary Ann died May 6, 1913 in Madison County, Alabama. They are buried in the Pettusville Cemetery.

Based on the 1870 and 1900 census data and a few guesses, the children included:

EMMETT MILES PUTMAN born in 1854 in Tennessee. In 1880 he is in Giles County, Tennessee with his wife Mary and five children. In 1910 they are in Madison County, Alabama. In 1920 he is widowed and living with his son Jack (John) in Madison County. He is with his married daughter Sallie in Limestone County in 1930 at age 84. Based on these census reports, I guess the children to be:

Lewis F. Putman born in Tennessee August 20, 1870. He died in Limestone County on January 30, 1893. I do not believe he married.

Jane Putman born in Tennessee in 1873.

John Putman born in Tennessee in 1874. In 1920 he is in Madison County with a wife

named Milly born in 1900 in Texas. She is obviously a second wife as at the time he had:

Larkin Putman born in 1900 in Alabama.

Ruby Putman born in 1903 in Alabama.

James Thomas Putman born in Tennessee March 8, 1877. He married Lee Alexander in Limestone County on April 20, 1898. She must have died shortly thereafter, as he married Viola Brown in about 1906, and they moved to Texas. They are in Hunt County, Texas in 1910. In 1920 and 1930 he is in Limestone County with Viola and these children:

Cary R. Putman born in Alabama in 1909.

Lester Noah Putman born in Texas in 1911. In 1930 he has a wife Emma and a daughter Helen. They are in Elkmont, Limestone County.

James T. Putman Jr. born in Alabama in 1913.

Clifford L. Putman born in Alabama in 1918.

Yate Putman a son born in 1920.

Edward Putman born in 1924.

Lillie Putman born in Tennessee March 13, 1878. She married Eugene White in Limestone County on April 24, 1898.

Andrew Jackson Putman born in 1880. He married Ella Mae White on April 3, 1898. They had three children. She must have died around 1904, and Andrew was at home in 1910. The children listed as grandchildren here in 1910 and 1920. I do not find Andrew in 1920, but the two youngest kids are still with Emmett, and Boss or Boaz is married. The children were:

Boss or Boaz Putman Boaz is a railroad term for boss. Anyway, he was born in 1899. In 1920 he is in Madison County with a wife named Lessie and a daughter named Hazel.

Melvin Putman born December 18, 1902. He is married to Georgia in Elkmont in 1930. He died in Wayne County, Michigan April 7, 1988.

Marie Putman born in 1904. Both these children were shown as being born in Tennessee in 1910 and in Alabama in 1920.

Henry Putman born in Alabama in 1886. He is home in 1910 and gone in 1920.

George Putman born in 1886 and died in 1935. He is home with his dad in 1910 in Madison County. In 1920, there is a George 'about the right age' in Limestone County, and in 1930 the right age. His wife is named Mary and they have these children:

Ernest Putman born in 1908. In 1930 he is married to Laura M. and they have James and Marvin.

Flossie Putman born in 1911.

Lucille Putman born in 1916.

Darkus Putman a daughter born in 1917.

Willie D. Putman born in 1920.

Alvie L. Putman a son born in 1921.

Sherman Putman born in 1923.

E. P. Putman a son born in 1924.

George E. Putman born in 1926.

Bessie Putman born in 1928.

Mary E. Putman born in 1929.

Sallie Putman born in 1891. She married Arthur Fish when she was 15 years old and they lived in Sand Springs, Limestone County. Her widowed ad was with them in 1930. At that time they had:

Arthur Fish born in 1914.

Woodrow Fish born in 1916.

RICHARD P. PUTMAN born August 15, 1856 and died April 2, 1947. He married Palmira Pluten in Giles County, Tennessee on December 24, 1887. She was born October 6, 1859 and died January 14, 1931. In 1900 she is listed as Mira so not certain which name is right. In fact her tombstone reads Myrie, but in 1910 and 1930 she used Palmira. In 1900 and 1910 they were in Limestone County, Alabama near his folks and had these children:

Lulu Putman born in Tennessee in September 1888.

Samuel Putman born in Alabama October 1, 1890 and died June 2, 1979. His wife Evelyn was born March 14, 1889 and died November 6, 1974. They lived in Elkmont, Limestone County. Children through 1930 were:

Jesse Putman born September 11, 1911. According to his obituary he was married to a Myrtle. He died in Athens, Alabama August 17, 2001.

Lessie Putman born in 1913.

Ollie Putman a son born in 1916. Missing in 1930.

Virginia Putman born in 1917. Not shown in 1920, may be the Ollie shown in 1930?

Jewel Putman born in 1918.

Pauline Putman born in 1922.

Cora A. Putman born in 1926.

Samuel Putman Jr. born in 1928.

George Putman born in 1930.

WILLIAM GEORGE PUTMAN born, according to his tombstone, August 30, 1866 and died in Athens on November 11, 1929. He was killed in a dynamite explosion while working on a highway construction project. He is in Limestone County in 1910 and in Madison County in 1920. He married Mary Lee 'Lizzie' Hill in Limestone County on August 7, 1890. Lizzie was born in Tennessee in 1873. She is widowed in Limestone County in 1930. Based on census reports and info from a descendent, their children were:

Estel Putman born in Tennessee in 1891. She married Arzie Slayton.

Pleasant William Emmett Putman born in Tennessee April 7, 1892. In 1920 he is in Madison County with a wife named Laura Ellen Hollingsworth. She was born February 24, 1900. Both died in Toledo, Ohio, Emmett on December 5, 1961 and Laura on May 5, 1956. In 1920 they had two children, the others are from a descendent:

Aretha M. Putman born in 1916 and died in 1988. She married Charles Emmett Holt.

Ozell Eva Putman born in 1918. She married Robert T. McGraw.

Aretha Rebecca Putman born in 1921. She married Luther T. Cochran.

James Reuben Putnam born in 1924 and died in 1987. He married Mary Lee Thomas.

William Thomas Putman born in 1930 and died 1986. He married Reba Dean Davis.

Gene Paul Putman born in 1932. He married Luthene Bassham.

Peggy Ann Putman born in 1938. She married William E. Fizer.

James Edward Putman born July 28, 1898. In the WWI registration of 1917 he lists his wife as Lucy. They are in Madison County along with his folks in 1920, and are back in Athens by 1930. A relative states her name was Lucy Lee Powers. Their tombstones indicate she was Lucy Harmon born December 6, 1898 and died September 18, 1974. Ed died November 20, 1951.

Luther Gilbert Putman born in 1900. He is in Limestone County in 1920 and 1930. He is married to Lydia Ann Powers and they have:

Mabel Putman born in 1921.

Stella Putman born in 1924.

Magdalene Putman born in 1925.

William Putman born in 1927.

Luther Putman born in 1929.

Naomi Putman born in 1903 and died in 1988. She married Adolph Ulrich.

Grover C. Putman born July 3, 1905 and died March 12, 1951 according to his tombstone. He married Flonnie West.

William Woodward Putman born in 1908. He married Ethella Lorraine Tilley.

Fanny Putman born in 1910. She first married Jesse Anglin and then Snooks Harrell.

Emma Putman born in 1913. She married Nolan Steele and then Olin Dudley.

Clemmie Putman a son born in 1913, twins I guess.

John Lester Putman born in 1916. He married Sara Jane Boyd.

NANCY PUTMAN born in 1865.

MALINDA 'MILLY' PUTMAN born in 1867-1868. She married Henry Pendergrass in Limestone County on April 11, 1889. It seems she died soon, as Henry married Janis Dugger on May 18, 1893.

SAMUEL PUTMAN born in 1869. He married Annie Daly on December 25, 1892 in Limestone County, Alabama. They were there through the 1920 census, and in Dyer County, Tennessee in 1930. Children to that point were:

Mattie Putman born in Tennessee in June 1894. She married Jim Willard and in 1930 they were with her folks in Tennessee.

Richard Putman born in Tennessee May 1, 1897. His wife was Florence. They were in Limestone County in 1930 with these kids.

Minnie Putman born in 1918.

Annie Putman born in 1921.

Mattie Putman born in 1923.

George S. Putman born in 1925.

James Putman born in Tennessee in 1926.

Marvin Putman born in 1930.

Elias Putman born in Tennessee August 25, 1900.

Emma Putman born in Alabama in 1901.

Ethel Putman born in Alabama in 1904.

Earl Putman born in 1905. In 1930 he is in Elkmont, and has a wife Bessie and these children:

Lena M. Putman born in 1924.

Christine Putman born in 1925.

Earl Putman Jr. born in 1928.

George Putman born in 1909.

Julia Putman born in 1912.

Clarence Putman born in 1914.

Virginia Putman born in 1917.

ELIZABETH PUTMAN born in 1881. She is still at home in 1900. She may or may not be a daughter, but was listed with the family in 1900. Not certain here.

Sarah Putman

Sarah was born 1836 in Tennessee. She was with her folks in Giles County in 1870. In 1880 she is still single at age 45 and living with two sisters and her brother Isaac. I do not find her in 1900.

Francis Putman

He was born in 1837 in Tennessee. He looks to be the guy in Creek County, Oklahoma in 1910. But I don't find him anywhere from 1850 till then, so not sure at all.

In the 1880 census of Lauderdale County, there was a POLLY PUTMAN living near the other Putmans in the area. The listing showed her as 41 AL TN TN and she had these children: Mary 19 AL, Sallie 19 AL, Will 10 AL and Mat, a daughter, 6 AL. Also very near was George Washington Putman who was probably her eldest at 20 AL.

At any rate, here are the children of Francis and Mary or Polly Putman, as near as I can determine. I have nothing on the daughters.

GEORGE WASHINGTON PUTMAN born in June 1855. In 1880 he is living very near both Polly Putman and Abel Putman. He married Mary E. Murphy on August 26, 1875 in St. Clair County, Alabama. They are still in Lauderdale County in 1900, 1910 and 1920. He is widowed by 1930 and living with his son Thomas. Children were:

William Sherwood Putman born April 17, 1881. He was in Lauderdale County in 1910 through 1930 with a wife named Dora and these children:

William Houston Putman born in 1904.

Maggie Putman born in 1906.

Mittie Putman born in 1884.

George Garvin Putman born January 21, 1886. In 1920 his wife was Luttie and they had:

Estes Putman born in 1913.

Clayton Putman born in 1915. He got married at age 14 to Catherine and they are living with his folks in 1930.

Thomas P. Putman born November 2, 1887. In 1920 and 1930 his wife was Georgia and they had:

Mary L. Putman born in August 1916.

Eugene D. Putman born in 1895. He has died by the 1900 census.

Jesse E. Putman born April 8, 1898 and died in Rogersville Alabama in December 1970. He is home in 1910 and not in the 1920 census. He is around in 1930 with a wife Verlie and these kids:

Louise Putman born in 1925.

Jesse Junior born in 1929 a twin.

Joyclan Putman a twin born in 1929.

MARY PUTMAN born in 1860.

SARAH or SALLIE PUTMAN born in 1860, twins.

WILLIAM R. PUTMAN born in 1871. He married Mattie Tolefero on December 17, 1893. I do not find them in 1900, but in 1910, Mattie is a widow with her mom, Fannie age 60, and these children:

Lizzie Putman born in 1896.
Emma Putman born in 1898.
John Putman born in 1902.
Myrtle Putman born in 1904.

MARTHA or MATTIE PUTMAN born in 1873.

Malinda Putman

She was born about 1839 to 1840 in Tennessee. I have a feeling that she and the next Mary are the same person. I find a Malinda in 1880 and Mary in 1900, but not both in any one year.

Mary Putman

Mary was born about 1840 in Tennessee. She was still unmarried in Limestone County in 1900. As above, I think Mary and Malinda are the same. Malinda was with her sister Nancy Reese in 1880 and Mary was with the Reese family in 1900.

Zedoc Putman

Zed was born about 1845 in Alabama. He is probably the 'Dedrick' listed next to dad in the 1870 Giles County census with a wife named Eliza.

In 1880 he and Eliza are in Lauderdale County with two children. Eliza must have died in the early 1880s, as on January 13, 1885 Zed married Nancy Crany or Croney from Lauderdale County. Zed died before 1900, as Nancy was widowed there in 1900 and living with her sister Susannah Croney. A couple of the boys are still around in 1900.

Best as I can determine from the 1880 and 1900 census reports there were three children. I have a contacted an 80 year old descendent, Jesse Putman, in Athens and he confirms this. Most of the information comes from him. Thanks Jesse. The children were:

ELIZABETH 'LIZZIE' PUTMAN born in 1876. She married Bill George Elders according to a relative in Athens. Their children were:

According to a relative, Jesse Putman, he then married Lula May Elders, born June 26, 1881, and went to Texas. He was in Collin County, Texas in 1910. Lula May died in childbirth November 11, 1917, and he then married Rosie King and returned to Limestone County, Alabama. She was born in Texas in about 1902. As of the 1930 census, the children with Lula Mae were:

Ella Mae Putman born in 1902.

William Putman born 1903. In 1930 he is in Slough, Limestone County with a wife named Alta with a daughter Norma born in 1929 and a son Leeton born in 1930.

Lee Roy Putman born March 12, 1908 and died October 26, 1960. He married Anna Bell McClusky.

Elmer Putman born March 13, 1909 and died March 25, 1976. He married Inez Furline.

Jesse Frank Putman the one giving me info on this family, was born September 11, 1911. He married Myrtle Clem. He died in Athens August 17, 2001.

Ruth Putman born in 1915. She first married Tom Peoples and later married Floyd Rodgers.

Lucile Putman born in 1916. She married John Milton.

Tommy Putman born in 1916. He married Laura Reese.

Jolene Putman born in 1917 when her mother died. She herself died a few months later.

George Frank then married Rossie King, and they had these children:

Leon Putman born in 1923.

Clara Mae Putman born in 1925 and married Marvin Green.

Ollie B. Putman born February 4, 1927. He married Bonnie Johns December 21, 1950. She was born June 7, 1931. They had:

Stephen Ollie Putman born December 23, 1951. He married Venus Gilliland and they had Stephen Ronald Putman born June 17, 1976. He later married Hazel Talley and they had Aaron Putman a daughter born September 23, 1987.

Theresa Putman born January 10, 1955. She married Walters and they had Tara Walters born October 16, 1975 who married Russell Newsome.

Irene Putman born October 25, 1957. She married Colbert and they had Elizabeth Marie Colbert born May 30, 2001 and Cassidy Dawn Colbert born April 7, 2003.

JAMES ISAAC PUTMAN was born, according to his tombstone, October 15, 1881 in Lauderdale County and died December 15, 1955 in Limestone County. According to his WWI registration, he is listed as being born on October 1, 1876. He married Mary Elizabeth Weems about 1900. She was born in June 1882 and died soon after they were married. They were living with her father in Lauderdale County for the 1900 census. He then married Lillie Mae King in about 1906. According to her tombstone, she was born March 13, 1887 and died December 24, 1956. They are in Limestone County in 1910, but I don't find their listing for 1920. They were shown in 1930 in Athens, Limestone County. In 1910, there were two daughters, the rest of the children come from James Putman, a son. They were:

Eva A. Putman born in 1908. She died as a child.

Mattie B. Putman born in March 1909. She also died young.

Bessie Putman born in 1911, and married Riley Arnold.

Eula Fay Putman born in 1914 and married Doyle Sessions.

Alberta Putman born in 1916, and married Harold Cannon.

Nova Putman born in 1918. She first married Jimmy Faucet and second married Herbert Isabel.

James E. Putman born December 29, 1920. He married Leora Smith. They live in Athens, Alabama and supplied the info on this family.

Isaac Putman born in 1921 and never married.

Willie Putman born in 1923. He married Julia George.

Beatrice Putman born in 1926, and married Mike Giarrantano.

Gladys Louise Putman born in 1929 and died as a child.

Kenneth Putman born in 1931 and married Jenny Camp. He lives in Birmingham.

Nancy (Nelly) Putman

She was born in May 1853 in Tennessee. She married a Reese. It appears she was a widow in 1880 in Lauderdale County with these two children:

JOHN REESE born in 1876 in Alabama. He married Az Scroggins. Their children were:

Iona Reese married Jim Guthrie.

Velma Reese married Peter DeBoise.

Marion Reese married May Pitts.

Floyd Reese married Corrine Fain.

Ollie Reese married a May.

James P. Putman

James was born in 1850 in Tennessee. In 1860 the family is in Lauderdale County, but for some reason he is not listed. He is, however, listed with the family in the 1870 census of Giles County, Tennessee at age 19.

In 1880 he is in Jasper County, Missouri with a wife named Mary L. born in Missouri in 1860. I do not find them yet in 1900.

As of 1880, the children were:

WILLIAM H. PUTMAN born in 1876 in Indian Territory, Oklahoma.

AMANDA PUTMAN born in Missouri in 1877.

Laura Putman

She was born in 1851 and home in 1870. I do not find her again.

James Isaac Putman

I am listing Ike here as I just do not know where else to put him. He never appears in Bazel's family, but appears with them most everywhere. He must be Bazel's, just not certain. Bazel was not found in the 1860 or 1870 census, so I just can't prove this.

Isaac was born about 1854. In 1880 he is in Lauderdale County with a wife named Belle age 22 and a young unnamed baby. At the time there are Nancy, Sarah and Malinda Putman there as well. They were his sisters. In 1900 he and Belle are still in Cross Roads, Lauderdale County.

I have spoken with a James Putman in Athens and his son John. James is a son of Lucian Putman. He informs me that Lucian or Lucas had two brothers and that their father was Ike. He didn't know Ike, nor did he have any info on him or who his wife was. But at least I know that Ike, whoever he was, had three sons. They are:

JOHN VINSON 'BEN' PUTMAN born in 1880. He married Annie Lash around 1909. In 1910 they were in Lauderdale County. He was 30 and she was 25. There were no children. Ben died in 1911 or 1912. Annie then married his brother Lucian Putman who had just lost his first wife, Myrtle. They had one child:

Pearl Nancy Putman born in about 1912 (she later states in was 1907, but was listed as 7 in the 1920 census). She married James Blackwell Brewer.

LUCIAN LEON PUTMAN born March 3, 1889 and died June 29, 1961. He was married twice. His first wife was Myrtle M. Cannup (? spelling), and she was with him in the 1910 census of Limestone County at age 20. She died after having the first child, Bennie. His second wife was Annie Lash born August 10, 1887 and died February 9, 1967. Annie was the wife of his brother Ben. When Ben died and after Myrtle died, Lucian married Annie about 1914. In 1920, Lucian and Annie have four children. James informs me that there were two more kids. They were:

Bennie Putman born August 10, 1910 and died August 19, 1986. In 1930 he has a wife Ruby and a daughter Reba. He is working the farm with his father.

James Putman born August 22, 1915. He lives in Athens, Alabama and supplied this info.

Elvira Putman born in 1918.

Louise Putman born in 1923.

Robert Hiram Putman born March 22, 1922 and died July 13, 1998.

FRANK PUTMAN born about 1890. He doesn't appear in 1900, but in 1910 is single and living in Limestone County living near Lucian Putman in Athens. He is single at the time. I do not find him in 1920. James Putman informs me that he was married twice. First to Rollie Hargroves and then to Sis Carter. That's all I have now.

EMMA PUTMAN born in March 1895. She was home in 1900.
