Joel Allen Putman

St. Clair Co. Alabama to Spalding Co. Georgia

Joel was a son of Reuben and Lucinda Putman. He was born in Kershaw, Laurens County, South Carolina on August 30, 1821.

He married Narcissa Coker on March 8, 1848 in St. Clair County, Alabama. Narcissa was born in Alabama in 1827. Narcissa died in the early 1860s and Joel then married Malinda Ann Sansom in St. Clair County on March 6, 1864. Malinda was born in Georgia on November 15, 1839.

Joel died in St. Clair County on April 26, 1891 and Malinda died on February 27, 1913 in Caddo County, Oklahoma while visiting her son Claude. Her body was returned to St. Clair County for burial.

Their children were:

FRANCIS ALLEN PUTMAN was born in 1849, and died in December 1897. He married Henrietta Elizabeth Sansom on September 6, 1868. She was born in December 1847. They were in Spaulding County, Georgia in the 1880 census. In 1900, Henrietta was widowed there with the following children:

Joel Albert Putman born October 19, 1869. He is married in Dooly County, Georgia in 1900. In 1910 he is in Ashburn, Turner County, Georgia with his wife Amanda Seymour, who is missing in 1920. He is by himself in Ashburn in 1920 and 1930. From a relative, it seems they divorced and neither ever remarried. Amanda is in Macon, Bibb County in 1920 and 1930 and says she is widowed to avoid embarrassment. Amanda was born August 24, 1869 and will die in Macon on September 15, 1970 at age 101. Children in the 1910 census were:

Clark Albert Putman born November 3, 1890, died January 15, 1970. He married Mamie Hudson, had a son Clark Albert Putnam jr.

Robert H. Putman born November 11, 1892. He changed his name to Robert Cowan, and moved to Pennsylvania.

Eunice Putman born March 2, 1895. She married Frank H. Riley.

Mamie Elizabeth Putman born November 3, 1897, and died October 10, 1984. She married Oscar Jackson, and had a daughter Mamie Jackson. They were divorced, and she married Jefferson Davis Alley in 1926. They had two children, Joe Putnam Alley b. 1927 and another son.

Nellie Putman born March 19, 1900, and died January 23, 1953. She was listed as Robie in one census, so her name may be Roberta and Nellie her middle name. She married Maynard Boardman Smith in 1920. They had two children, Roland Smith and Nell Smith.

Glen Harrison Putman born in January 1872. He was home in 1900 with his mom in Spaulding County, Georgia. I don't find him again till 1930 when he and his wife Jemima are in Coweta County. From findagrave.com we get Glenn born January 30, 1872 and died in Coweta County February 19, 1948. Elizabeth Jim (Jemima) was born June 9, 1981 and died December 27, 1947.

Cora Putman was born March 3, 1908 and died September 8, 1978.

Ralph Putman was born March 25, 1911 and died in July 1979.

Frank Burke Putman born March 24, 1874. He died in Spaulding County, Georgia October 25, 1945. In 1910 and 1920 he is in Spaulding County Georgia with his wife Emma Kennedy and one child:

Merrill Putman born in 1907. He will marry Vera Harris.

James Oscar Putman born in March 1874. He married Sally Alma Pollard in February 1900. He is listed as Oscar J. with his family, and then has his own listing with Sally Ann later on. In 1910 they are in Fayette County, Georgia. I don't find them in 1920 but in 1930 he is widowed with the kids in Campbell County. Based on the censuses he had these children:

Clessie Putman a daughter born February 12, 1901. She died March 30, 1981 in DeKalb County Georgia. She never married.

Curtis Opal Putman a daughter born April 8, 1902, died March 15, 1945 in DeKalb County, Georgia. She never married.

Genice Oscar Putman a son born in 1904 and died in Fulton County August 22, 1948.

Madge Putman born in 1907.

Cecil Putman born in 1910.

James Oscar Putman Jr. born July 26, 1913 and died in DeKalb County June 6, 1956.

Wendell Putman born in 1915.

Agnes Putman born in 1919.

Geneviva Putman born in February 1876. She married Oslo Biles on October 6, 1894. She is back with her mom in 1900.

Lee Hiram Putman born in 1879. In the 1880 but not 1900 census. In 1910 through 1930, he is in Montgomery County, Texas. His wife is Eula Everett from Georgia. In 1910, they are with her folks, and in 1920 her mom, Sarah Everett, is still with them.

The children through 1930 were:

Effie Putman born in 1897, gone or married by 1920.

Elbert Putman born in 1900 in Texas.

Earl Putman born in 1904 in Georgia.

Theo Putman a son born in 1910 and died before 1920.

Alaine Putman born in Texas in 1913.

Cary Putman a son born in August 1882.

Paul Putman born February 19, 1885. In 1910 he is in Spaulding County, Georgia with his wife Addie Maude Fulham, born in 1886, and one son. At the time they are living with Addie's folks James and Susan Fulham. He worked as a blacksmith in a rock quarry as did James Fulham. I don't find him in 1920 but he is here. By 1930 he has ten kids. He died there June 21, 1959 at age 74. Maude died March 20, 1975.

Ernest P. Putman born in 1908 and died November 11, 1961.

Thelma Putman born in 1911.

Jewell Putman born in 1914.

Brewer Putman a son born January 6, 1915 and died in Atlanta in December 1967..

Opal Putman born in 1917.

Catherine Putman born in 1919.

Edna Putman born in 1921.

Margaret Putman born in 1923.

George Putman born in 1925.

Evelyn Putman born in 1927.

Anna Lee Putman born in April 1886.

SANFORD ALLEN PUTMAN was born October 20, 1850. He married Marie E. Leach about 1871 and they had 7 children. They lived in Spaulding County, Georgia. Marie died March 15, 1903 and Sanford married Nancy Harrison on January 27, 1904. He died May 29, 1920 and Nancy died July 27, 1945 both in Spaulding County, Georgia. Children, all with Marie were:

Nancy Olla Putman born in 1872. She married Charles M. Biles in Spaulding County, Georgia on May 7, 1887. She died December 24, 1906.

Marianne Mittie May Putman born November 11, 1873. She married Jim D. Biles on September 30, 1888. She died January 26, 1936.

John Edward Putman born March 4, 1876. He married Mary Ann Harrison in Spaulding County, Georgia on December 20, 1895. He died April 30, 1924. Mary Ann died December 28, 1936. Their children were:

Edward Owen Putman born October 13, 1898. He married Carrie Lou Ashley. After she died, he married Rochelle Shivers. Then after he died, Rochelle married Gus Brown.

Mary Eulice Putman born April 1, 1900. She married Roy Samuel Echols.

Nancy Ethelene Putman born April 15, 1901. She married Ralph Mason.

Mattie Olivia Putman born December 10, 1903. She married William P. Cheeney.

Wallace Putman born about 1904 died as an infant.

Lotte Belle Putman born November 1, 1906.

Joel Raymond Putman born August 26, 1914. He married Betsy Parker.

Sanford Ellis Putman born January 20, 1878. In 1900 his wife was Stella Maynard born November 1876 and they had two children. He married Estelle Maynard on October 17, 1897. He died April 10, 1936. Stella died January 26, 1965 at age 88. Children as of 1900 were:

Grace Putman born after 1910 and died soon afterwards.

Judge Allen Putman born August 21, 1879. In 1900 his wife was Hattie Williams and they had a 1 month old daughter. He had married Hattie Williams December 29, 1898. He died January 5, 1939 or in another source he died June 26, 1959, not too certain here. In 1900, 1910 and 1920 they had:

Lois Putman born in 1902.

Lloyd C. Putman born in 1903. He is married to Leslie in 1930 with two kids. He died in Spalding County June 26, 1959.

Judge Clark Putman born in 1906. He has a wife Thelma and a daughter in 1930. He died in Spalding County August 22, 1988.

Marie Cornelia Putman born June 1, 1881 and died May 13, 1887.

Arthur Eldridge Putman born August 27, 1885 and died May 12, 1887.

NANCY JANE PUTMAN was born November 12, 1851. She married the Reverend Joseph E. Stevenson in St. Clair County, Alabama on July 20, 1871. Joseph was born August 17, 1849 and died August 8, 1915. Their children were:

JOEL MADISON PUTMAN was born July 18, 1856. He married Matilda Mary Sansom,

born August 14, 1848, in Fayette County, Georgia on November 11, 1877. He too went to Spaulding County Georgia. He died July 23, 1923 of prostate cancer. Their children were:

Theodore Sansom Putman born March 12, 1884.

Glenn Harrison Putman born April 8, 1886. He married Ollie Belle Love on October 22, 1911. He died in Upson County, Georgia on January 14, 1940. Ollie Belle was born June 20, 1890 and died October 20, 1962 in Houston, Texas. In 1920 they were in Upson County, Georgia with these children:

JOHN WILLIAM PUTMAN born in September 1862. He married Elizabeth Ann Tankersley, born July 30, 1858, in Georgia and died May 12, 1906. She was a daughter of Andrew and Martha Tankersley. He then married Willie E. Davis (widow of a Thelman guy) in 1909. Willie was born October 4, 1874 and died June 4, 1946. In 1900 they are in St. Clair County, Alabama with five children. They were there in 1910, 1920 and 1930. John died November 3, 1933 in St. Clair County. The children, all in the first marriage, were:

William Cullen Bryant Putman born March 29, 1881. He was single in Douglas County, Georgia in 1900 and in 1910 was in St. Clair County, Alabama with a wife named Annie Mae and no children yet. I don't find him in 1920. Annie was born September 3, 1888 and died September 5, 1945. William died June 8, 1960.

Annie Putman born in October 1882. Home in 1910. Her full name seems to have been Rucker. She married a Washington guy, and died June 3, 1911. In 1910 and 1920, her daughter **Dora** is living with her folks. Dora was born June 30, 1899 and died March 6, 1967.

Arty L. Putman born April 22, 1883 and died April 30, 1885.

Louis Putman born February 22, 1888, a twin. He died June 24, 1931. He married Winnie Horton, born March 14, 1887 and died June 20, 1911. He then married her twin sister Nena W. Horton, born March 14, 1887 and died December 24, 1963. In 1920 he is with Nena and four children in Whortons Bend, Etowah County. They are in Ashville, St. Clair County in 1930. All in all, the children were:

Lillie Mae Putman born in 1911. She married a Blackwell.

Ella Lou Putman born in 1913.

Myrtle E. Putman born in 1914.

Agnes Putman born in August 1916.

L. B. Putman a son born in 1922.

Johnnie L. Putman a son born in 1924.

Lucius S. Putman born February 22, 1888 and died October 15, 1966, the other twin. He was with his brother John in Tuscaloosa County in 1910. He married Icie Bell, born April 7, 1891 and died September 1, 1953. He was executor of his father's estate. He finally settled it some 40 years later when his other brothers and sisters sued him to do so.

John Thelman Putman born July 8, 1891 and died November 5, 1920 of tuberculosis. In the 1910 census he is away from home and living in Tuscaloosa County with his brother Lucius.

Myrtie Putman born in October 1893 and died in 1986. She married Will A. Gunter.

Ella Mae Putman born December 19, 1894. She married John Euell Panell.

Infant Son Putman born and died June 22, 1895.

FRANCES VALULA 'LULA' PUTMAN born February 28, 1865, and died February 11, 1945. She married Joseph Allen Lowery on February 1, 1880. Her mother was with them in 1900. The children were:

Malinda Ann Lowery born December 25, 1880. She married Claud Jester on November 7, 1897.

John William Lowery born September 5, 1882. He married Viola Runyan November 19, 1899.

Georgia Della Lowery born December 15, 1884.

Joseph Allen Lowery, Jr. born December 29, 1886. He married Nancy Moore.

Leslie Leverett Lowery born February 14, 1889.

Samuel Henry Lowery born February 23, 1891. He married Eula Burger

Clara or Clelar Lowery born April 3, 1893. She married Oscar Runyan.

Maude Esther Lowery born April 13, 1895. She married Noel Burger.

Clementine Viola Lowery born June 26 1897. She married Ernest Baker.

His wife is Clara Belle Edmondson, born March 18, 1872 and died April 5, 1939 in Oklahoma City. They had the following children, all in Oklahoma City in the 1920 census:

Algernon Carlile Putnam born October 17, 1889 in Birmingham, Alabama. His wife was named Haley. He died in Oklahoma City January 30, 1966.

Jewell Irene Putnam born November 7, 1891, and died April 16, 1958. She married Tivis Nelson.

Everrett Grady Putnam born April 25, 1895 in McKinney, Texas. His wife was named Gertrude.

Pauline Lucille Putnam born September 14, 1897. She married Bill Peters

Linnie Edel Putnam born October 7, 1901. She married a Garrett, we think.

Louis Claude Putnam born April 24, 1904, the last child born in Steele, Alabama.

Gertrude Mae Putnam born May 11, 1906 the first born in Eakley, Oklahoma. She married Tex McGovern.

Velma Christine Putnam born December 9, 1909. She married Everet Munson.

Nannie Marie Putnam born March 3, 1911 in Eakley, Oklahoma. She married John Waters.

Alma Katherine Putnam born July 4, 1913 in Oklahoma City. She first married a Waggoner, and then married Willard Randol.

Joseph Ronald Putnam born April 17, 1918 and died in Oklahoma City March 17, 1992. He was married several times, but his children were with Alice Jean Coffman. His daughter, Penny, supplied the info on this family. Thanks.

LUCINDA ALTA PUTMAN born December 7, 1868. She married Gustavisi Islus Palmer on November 26, 1885. He was born October 17, 1864 and died February 18, 1933. Lucinda died November 12, 1940.

WILLIAM B. PUTMAN born in about 1870. He is with his mother and sister, Lula Lowery in 1900. In 1920 and 1930 he is in Caddo County, Oklahoma with a wife Lula (possibly Privett), born 1884 in Alabama, and these children:

Catherine Putman born in Oklahoma in 1913.

GLEN REUBEN PUTMAN born in 1873 in St. Clair County, Alabama. There is a marriage record of a G. R. Putman marrying a Sally Ann Jones on December 24, 1891. In 1900 she is shown alone in Spaulding County with these two children:

I am not positive this is he, but he is missing everywhere in the 1900 census. He did marry Minnie C. Worsley June 30, 1903 in Wilcox County, Georgia. Minnie had previously married Joseph Ellis and had three Ellis Children with her. They were divorced in 1921, and he married Mary Roberts in Fitzgerald, Ben Hill County on August 22, 1922. They remained married until his death in Fitzgerald on August 26, 1939. He was a constable in Fitzgerald. The child with Minnie was:

CICERO D. (DUDLEY) PUTMAN born in June 1876. In 1900, he is in Hill County, Texas living with a Charles Ryan. He is also listed then in Jefferson County, Alabama. He was studying to be a dentist there. It would appear he married a Connors girl, had a son and then she died. The son, Cicero Junior, is living with his grand parents in Hill County in 1910, 1920 and 1930. Cicero Senior is in Muskogee County, Oklahoma in 1920 with a wife Nora born in Tennessee in 1872 and no children. He was a dentist. The only child I am aware of was:

Dudley Godall Putman born in Hill County, Texas August 14, 1902. After his mom died, his dad left him with his grandfather Connors, and went to Oklahoma with a second wife. Dudley married Willie Mae Griffin. She was born April 16, 1904 and died in Hill County March 19, 1995. Dudley died there August 5, 1979.

CLAUDIS E. PUTMAN born in December 1877. He is married and in Caddo County, Oklahoma in 1910. His wife is Ida Mae and his mother, Malinda, is there with him. Malinda died in 1913. Claude and Ida Mae are there in 1920. Their child was:

Leroy Putman born in 1915.

LUTHER A. PUTMAN born in 1880. He is single in 1900 in St. Clair County. He married Maude Florence Brewster in St. Clair County on September 21, 1902. They moved to Texas and are in Palo Pinto County in 1910 and in Tarrant County in 1920. The only child was:

Pauline Putman born in 1903 in Texas.
