Simeon Howard Putman

Kentucky to Marion County Alabama

This Simeon was a son of Simeon Putman and Peggy Mercer. He was born March 7, 1812 in Barren County Kentucky. He married Sarah Caroline Teague in Benton County Alabama November 1, 1837. Sarah was a daughter of Samuel Teague and Mary Pearson and was born in Abbeville County South Carolina March 12, 1819. They were there in 1840 and 1850. Benton County became Calhoun County and they were in Talladega County Alabama in 1860, but I do not find them in that census. In 1870 they are in Cleburne County Alabama.

By 1880, he has moved to Marion County Alabama and is 67 and Sarah is 59. His son John is in the county as well.

Simeon died November 1, 1888 in Marion County. In 1900 Sarah, then 79, is living as the mother in law of Marshall Norton in Lawrence County Alabama. Marshall had married her daughter Martha Ann. Sarah died in Marion County August 20, 1900.

The children of Simeon and Sarah Putman were:

MARTHA PUTMAN born in 1840. She must have died as they had another daughter named Martha born in 1853.

WILLIAM C. PUTMAN born in 1841. In the 1870 census of St. Clair County Alabama there is a widow Jane Putman born in Alabama in 1840. Her maiden name was Stafford as her mom is with her. They lived near Joel and his family in Ashville. I guess she married William about 1861 and he died in the Civil War. There was one child:

John Putman born in 1862.

JOHN HOWARD PUTMAN born October 19, 1843. He is in St. Clair County Alabama in 1870 with his wife Cerina and the first three children. In the 1880 census, he is in Marion County Alabama with his folks next door. His wife is Cerina Frances Adkins, they were married August 26, 1861. Cerina was a daughter of Thomas M. Adkins and Jane Hawkins originally from Rutherford County North Carolina. She was born October 12, 1846. John was a blacksmith as well as a farmer. He patented a cultivator plow in 1890 and manufactured it for the Hughes Springs Plow Company. He got a royalty of 50 cents per plow sold. In 1900, he is with his son Lewis in Cass County Texas at age 55. Cerina had died in 1899. John died in Stacy, McCulloch County Texas on November 21, 1908. This family is more fully covered in the section on **TEXAS PUTMANS**. They had these children:

John Forney Putman born in October 3, 1862. He is in Wood County Texas in 1900 with a wife named Nancy Maria Cox. They are in Kaufman County Texas in 1910 and missing in 1920. See **TEXAS PUTMANS**.

Mary Lucinda Putman born December 31, 1865. She married Rufus Napoleon Cox in Marion County on January 19, 1882. Rufus was a son of Mordica and Nancy E. Cox and was born in Alabama February 11, 1862 and died in Cass County Texas March 17,

1949. They had five children.

Dora Clementine Cox born November 15, 1883 in Alabama and died in Cass County Texas May 10, 1965. She married Shelton Watts Stiles in about 1900.

Mordecai I. Cox born November 11, 1899 and died August 19, 1890.

Ira Napoleon Cox born August 11, 1891 and died in Cass County Texas March 12, 1962.

C. N. Cox a son born about 1892.

Mary Elizabeth Cox born February 9, 1893 and died in Cass County Texas May 7, 1961. She married Taylor Brooks Smith in Sevier County Arkansas August 15, 1916.

Sarah Elizabeth Putman born March 14, 1867, and married John Wesley Peck. He was born March 4, 1861 and died in Sevier County Arkansas January 15, 1944. Sarah or Sallie died there November 19, 1930. They had six children:

James Robert Peck born in Texas December 3, 1887 and died in Sevier County Arkansas January 17, 1968. His wife Lena Elizabeth was born in Texas August 31, 1902 and died in Arkansas April 1, 1979. They had three children.

Mary Elizabeth Peck born in January 1890 in Texas and died in Fort Smith, Arkansas May 25, 1979. She married Rayford Pat McAlpin November 7, 1921. He was born in Texas March 24, 1901 and died in Fort Smith, Arkansas May 4, 1984.

Minnie Peck born in April 1891 in Texas.

Louella Peck born in Texas in March 1893 and died in St. Louis County Missouri February 6, 1976. She married Amos Coy Burns in Oklahoma October 30, 1913. He was born in Texas August 13, 1892 and died in St. Louis, Missouri January 26, 1966. They had seven children including twins born and died in 1915.

Wesley Peck born in Texas in October 1896.

Rufus Peck born about 1907 in Arkansas.

James Edward Putman born and died in 1869.

Lewis Simuel Putman born August 15, 1870. He married Bertha Jarrett in Cass County Texas on March 24, 1895. He died in Mineral Wells, Texas on April 26, 1952. Bertha was born November 26, 1879 in Atlanta, Georgia and died in Dickens, Texas on January 11, 1930. See **TEXAS PUTMANS**.

Thomas J. Putman born August 28, 1872. He married Lillie Viola Boyd, and died in 1902. Lillie then married his brother Andrew in 1905.

Joseph Marshall Putman born in 1875.

Martha Magdaline Putman born in 1876.

Frances Cyrena Putman born in 1877. She married a Boyd.

Eliza M. Putman born in 1879. She married Walter Coleman McAlpin in 1895 in Morris County Texas. He was born in Cass County Texas in 1870 and died in Fort Smith, Arkansas in 1931. Eliza died there in 1942.

Andrew Madison Putman born May 30, 1881. He married his brother Thomas' widow Viola Lillie Boyd on September 28, 1907 and moved to Morris County Texas by 1920. See **TEXAS PUTMANS**.

Silas Moore Putman born May 11, 1883. He married Emma Susan Jarrett October 1, 1905 and they spent their lives in Cass County Texas. See **TEXAS PUTMANS**.

Lillie Magdalene Putman born in Texas November 11, 1885. She married Thomas Stephen Jarrett on January 26, 1902. They moved to Navarro County Texas. She died April 2, 1959, and he died August 2, 1969.

Cerina Melcina Putman born in Texas November 20, 1888. She married Archie Preston Perser and remained in Cass County Texas. He died and she married his cousin George Washington Perser September 26, 1944. He was born January 11, 1875 and died in 1963. She died in Linden, Cass County September 7, 1964.

MARY FRANCES PUTMAN born in 1845.

MARGARET L. PUTMAN born September 11, 1847. She married Abner Madison Hill in about 1866. They had two children in Cleburne County and then in 1870 moved with Abner's father, Ivy Hill to Cass County Texas where they had five more children. Margaret died December 6, 1906 and Abner died February 27, 1928, both are buried in the Watson Cemetery in Cass County. Their children were:

Silas Mercer Hill born April 25, 1868 and died February 11, 1946. He married Elsie Arilla Long on December 23, 1888.

James Albert Hill born September 1, 1870 and died January 5, 1929. He married Ollie Barnett September 22, 1892.

Coleman Lafayette Hill born July 4, 1871 and died February 16, 1946. He married Lydia Ann Baugus February 23, 1894.

John M. Hill born in 1875 and died December 28, 1901. He married Ola Cheekwood September 25, 1896.

Sarah E. Hill born in 1876.

Ida Hassaltine Hill born February 23, 1878 and died February 26, 1952. She married John M. Daniel.

Lucy Ella Hill born March 22, 1886 and died January 4, 1967. She married Henry Tolleson.

JAMES PUTMAN in Alabama October 8, 1849. He is still at home in 1870 in Calhoun County. In 1900 and 1910 he is in Sturgeon, Cooke County Texas with his wife Frances Melinda Majors born September 9, 1859 in Alabama and died July 11, 1942 in Sturgeon, Texas. He died there January 2, 1913. They had these children:

Thomas Jefferson Putman born in Alabama in August 1873. He appears in 1900 with his parents and his wife Lillie Viola Boyd born in August 1872 and they had a daughter Cora. He died in 1902 or 1903 and Lillie remarried a cousin Andrew Madison Putman September 29, 1907 in Cass County. They were in Cass County and then Morris County Texas. Andrew was a son of John Howard Putman and Cerina Atkins from Blount County Alabama and then Cass County Texas. See the **TEXAS PUTMANS** for the family of Andrew and Lillie.

William Newton Putman born in Fort Smith, Arkansas August 22, 1882. In 1910 and 1920, he is in Cooke County Texas with a wife named Minnie Lee Schumaker born in Texas in 1887 and in Lubbock County in 1930. Minnie was born in Texas June 15, 1887 and died in Hansford County Texas June 20, 1974. William died out in Los Angeles September 9, 1964. They had these children:

James Paul Putman born in Cooke County November 26, 1906 and died in Lubbock, Texas December 5, 1934.

Jerry Clayton Putman born November 10, 1908 and died in Lubbock, Texas October 3, 1962.

Harold Putman born June 29, 1911 and died in Fort Worth on August 9, 1997.

Lydia Putman born in 1912.

Diddi or Biddie Putman born in 1915.

Gladys Putman a twin born on February 25, 1919.

Glenn Putman a twin born February 25, 1919 and died January 23, 1936.

Frances Putman born in Oklahoma in 1925.

Ralph Putman born in Oklahoma in 1928.

John Wesley Putman born in Arkansas on January 18, 1884. He is in Cooke County through 1920. By 1930, the kids are in Lubbock County with his sister Viola and he is

missing. His wife was Corrine 'Carrie' King born 1884 in Texas and died there in 1923. They had these children:

Wayne Gilcrease Putman born April 14, 1912 and died in Lubbock May 24, 2006. He married Minnie Mae Howard in Curry County New Mexico December 9, 1950.

John Weldon Putman born February 22, 1915 and died in Lubbock January 11, 1999. His wife Oneta Ayers was born August 27, 1914 and died in Lubbock July 4, 1977. They moved to Lubbock, Texas and he founded Putman Concrete there in 1956. They had Sheri Hollis Putman and Wayne Putman.

Clay Alvin Putman born December 7, 1918 and died in Lubbock September 19, 1994.

Simeon Howard Putman born in Texas on October 25, 1886. He is at home in Gainesville, Cooke County from 1900 through 1920. By 1930 he is married to Eula May Harrison. Eula was born April 15, 1901 and died January 30, 1996. Howard died January 15, 1948. They are buried in Fairview Cemetery here in Gainesville. They had one son:

Billy Ray Putman born September 19, 1927 in Cooke County and died there August 20, 1996. He was married when he enlisted in the Army Air Corps January 25, 1946.

Viola Putman born in Cass County Texas December 7, 1888 and died October 31, 1972 in Lubbock, Texas. She married David Marvin King about 1912. He was born May 28, 1885 in Cooke County and died December 2, 1965. They had:

Annie Pauline King born March 5, 1913 and died in Lubbock May 31, 1991.

Blanche L. King born about 1915.

Walton A. King born about 1919.

Wiley F. Putman born in Texas March 6, 1890. He died June 24, 1912.

Pearl Putman born in Texas in March 1894.

Sarah Frances (Fanny) Putman born in Texas June 18, 1896 and died January 13, 1980. She married Sidney Magers about 1914. He was born June 27, 1884 and died October 12, 1948. Both died in Gainesville, Cooke County. They had:

Morris Edwin Magers born November 29, 1915 and died in Dallas March 12, 2007.

Marshall Putman Magers born about 1920.

SARAH L. PUTMAN born in 1852.

MARTHA A. PUTMAN born March 12, 1853, and she died March 27, 1917. She married Marshall Norton in Lawrence County on January 14, 1874. In 1880 they were living with or next to her parents in Marion County Alabama. Her mother was living with them in 1900. As of 1900, the children were:

Della Frances Norton born December 3, 1878.

Ada Norton born in October 1882.

Simeon Norton born in March 1885.

Oscar Norton born in May 1892.

Cora Norton born in April 1897.
