

THE BRAZELTON FAMILY

Family tradition states that the earliest ancestor we have records of, John Brazelton, was a Welch carpenter that came to America in the early 1700s. Nothing has been proved and many others feel the family was originally of French Huguenot origin from Gascony who fled religious persecution and went to England and Wales in the late 1500s. Other researchers feel the family was from the Palatinates or Rhine region of Germany. At this point, we have no real proof one way or the other.

The original immigrant, John Brazelton, came to Maryland, probably after landing in Philadelphia or Baltimore. He and his family moved to Frederick County in central Maryland. One of his sons, William, became a Quaker and his daughter, Jean, married William Haworth and so the line became part of our Canaday Family. Another son, Jacob, moved to the Carolinas and then Georgia and one of his daughters, Hannah, married Ezekiel Putman, a member of my own family, in the old Pendleton District of South Carolina. Once again, this shows how small the population was in those early colonial days. The Brazeltons are cousins on my side and on my wife's side.

I will begin my brief history of the Brazelton family with John Brazelton, the first known member of the family.

JOHN BRAZELTON

John was most likely born in the 1700 to 1710 time period. Where it is not known, but I think it would have been in Wales no matter where the family originated. He sailed to America in the early 1730s and either landed in Baltimore, Maryland or traveled there shortly after arriving in America.

He was married, probably in Baltimore, to Mary Bridget Crawford or Matilda Bridget Crawford. Bridget seems to have been the name she used as this was how she signed a deed as the wife of John Brazelton. They were married in the early 1730s as their first child was born in 1734.

Tradition has it that John met Bridget aboard the ship to America and then married her in Baltimore. Bridget was most likely from Ireland and again tradition has it that she came from a wealthy family.

John worked as a carpenter in Baltimore and is reported to have built the first barn in Baltimore. Nothing else is known of John in Baltimore.

In 1746, he has a deed recorded showing he owned lands in Frederick County, Maryland. He may well have been living there prior to that date, but no proof is available.

He remained in Frederick County, Maryland for the remainder of his life. He wrote his will January 31, 1788 and died sometime in July of that year. The will was proven on August 7, 1788. Bridget was still alive at that time.

John and Bridget Brazelton had the following seven children:

William Brazelton

William Brazelton, the eldest child, was born January 12, 1734 in Maryland. He married Sarah Shepherd on December 12, 1758. This is our line and William and his family are covered in the next section of this history.

Elizabeth Brazelton

Elizabeth, or Betsey as she was called, was born in 1738 in Maryland, probably in Baltimore. She was married to a Williams man and had at least one child. They moved to Kentucky after they were married.

When her family was attacked by Indians in Kentucky in 1778, she hid with her young baby behind a waterfall on her farm and was rescued by General Clarke. Her brother John was killed in the same attack.

Elizabeth died in Kentucky sometime after 1788.

Isaac Brazelton

Isaac was born in about 1740 and it could have been in either Baltimore, or more likely, in Frederick County, Maryland. His wife was named Mary, no maiden name known, though some feel it might be Head.

He served as a soldier from Frederick County during the American Revolution. He was among the '*Associators*' or deputies sent by Frederick County to get news from the Continental Congress in 1784. Isaac seems to have remained in Frederick County until he sold his land by deed dated May 1791. He had received a land grant, probably Bounty Land for war service, in Hawkins County, Tennessee. I do not know if he went there, for in 1792 he moved to the west side of Long Lick Creek in Washington County, Kentucky. It was here that he died sometime around 1810 to 1812.

Isaac and Mary had seven children:

JOHN BRAZELTON born in the early 1770s. He married Catherine Westerfield in Madison County, Kentucky on January 7, 1793. Catherine was born October 15, 1770 in Conewago, Pennsylvania. John died in Lancaster, Jefferson County, Indiana on January 17, 1827. Catherine died on August 23, 1849 in North Madison, Indiana. Their children were:

Mary Brazelton born December 22, 1794 in Kentucky and died as a child.

Rebecca Brazelton born in Kentucky on October 5, 1796 and also died young.

Isaac Westerfield Brazelton born January 5, 1798. He married Elizabeth Thompson in Washington County, Kentucky on October 5, 1819. They had five children. Elizabeth died in Sardinia, Decatur County, Indiana on December 21, 1862 (bummer Christmas that year). Isaac then married Hulda Baker on June 2, 1863 in Jennings County, Indiana. He died February 24, 1873 in Jackson, Decatur County, Indiana. I do not know when Hulda died.

James Brazelton born June 7, 1800 in Washington County. He married Catherine 'Kelly' Baxter on October 25, 1823 in Jessamine County, Kentucky. Kelly was about thirteen at the time. They had six children. She died August 8, 1888 and he died July 22, 1890, both in Madison, Jefferson County, Indiana.

Edward Brazelton born April 22, 1802. He married Cynthia Loring, a widow with apparently ten children. I do not know if they had any together. They were married about 1839. Edward died sometime after the 1880 census.

John Brazelton Jr. born October 7, 1804. He married Elizabeth Stevens in Jefferson County, Indiana on January 3, 1826. He died two years later in October 1828 in New Orleans, Louisiana. Elizabeth then married his brother William. Elizabeth was born October 18, 1811 and died July 22, 1841. They had one son.

William Brazelton born January 29, 1806 in Mercer County, Kentucky. He married his brother's widow, Elizabeth Stevens Brazelton on October 14, 1829. He died October 8, 1890 in Jefferson County, Indiana. They had five children.

Eliza Jane Brazelton born December 29, 1810 in Mercer County, Kentucky and died April 4, 1895 in Indianapolis, Indiana. She first married William Baxter Brazelton (son of William coming up soon) on August 15, 1825. William died in the late 1830s and she then married George Clemmons on June 15, 1845. She had three children in the first marriage and none in the second. She died April 4, 1895 in Indianapolis.

MARTHA BRAZELTON was born in Frederick County, Maryland in about 1774. She married Henry Head in about 1808 in Kentucky. She died before 1825 in Madison County, Illinois. Henry died October 3, 1840 in Edwardsville, Illinois. Their children were:

Bigger John Head born 1809 and died February 2, 1856. He married Indiana Coventry on July 11, 1835. They had two sons.

Ann Head born in 1810 and died August 8, 1826.

Martha Caroline Head born about 1814 and died about 1836. She married Riley Graves in Lebanon, Illinois on June 11, 1831. They had five children.

WILLIAM BRAZELTON was born in Frederick County, Maryland about 1776. He married Rebecca Westerfield in Indiana on July 21, 1796. She was born June 9, 1779 and died after 1850. William died around 180 to 1812. They had two sons that I have info on:

Edward Brazelton born about 1802.

William Baxter Brazelton born May 25, 1806. He married his cousin, Eliza Jane Brazelton on August 15, 1825 in Jefferson County, Indiana. He died in the mid 1830s and Eliza married George Clemmons in 1825.

ELIZABETH B. BRAZELTON was born April 17, 1779 in Frederick County, Maryland. She married Francis Berry in Washington County, Kentucky on November 25, 1799. Betsy died in Springfield, Washington County, Kentucky on April 3, 1848. Francis had died sometime prior to this. They had six children:

Richard Berry born about 1800.

Mary Head Berry born in 1801. She married William Hudson Mitchell February 6, 1822 in Washington County.

Rachel Berry born in 1803.

Isaac Newton Berry born in 1806.

Nancy B. Berry born in 1808.

Elizabeth Berry born in 1810.

EDWARD BRAZELTON was born August 17, 1780 in Frederick County, Maryland. He never married and died in Mercer County, Kentucky on February 3, 1858.

MARY (POLLY) BRAZELTON was born about 1784 and died in Washington County, Kentucky in the early 1840s. She married Edward Berry December 15, 1808. They had these children:

Richard Berry born in 1809.

William J. Berry

Edward Berry

Mary Ann Berry who married James R. Mitchell.

Naomi Berry who married a Redding man.

Amanda Berry who married a Buckley.

Daughter Berry who married a Pendleton.

ANN BRAZELTON was born in the late 1780s and died about 1840. She married Joseph Smith May 1, 1814 in Washington County, Kentucky. The only child I have info on was:

William Smith born in Ohio County, Kentucky in 1823. He married Hester Ann Taylor.

John Brazelton Jr.

John was born in Frederick County, Maryland on April 13, 1741. He married Sarah Justice sometime about 1769 to 1771 also in Frederick County.

He moved with his family to Kentucky and then to Guilford County, North Carolina. It was there that he died on March 14, 1781. Sally died in about 1827.

The children that I know about were:

PHEBE BRAZELTON born in Frederick County, Maryland on September 4, 1772. She married Joseph Spurgin in Guilford County on January 10, 1793. Joseph was born in Rowan County, North Carolina on April 20, 1770 and died in Davidson County, North Carolina on May 20, 1859. Phebe died there on August 6, 1827. Their children were:

Sarah Spurgin born September 17, 1793 and died in Saline, Pettis County, Missouri on March 7, 1874. She married Absolom Williams on November 20, 1817 in Rowan County. They had seven children.

Josiah Spurgin born October 27, 1795 and died August 4, 1802 in Davidson County.

John Spurgin born June 24, 1797 in Rowan County and died July 23, 1881 in Davidson County, North Carolina. He married Sarah Raper on May 6, 1819 in Guilford County. They had ten children.

William Spurgin born July 18, 1799 and died December 5, 1837 in Stokes County, North Carolina. He married Margaret Mock on May 29, 1821. They had six children.

Reverend Isiah Spurgin born January 14, 1802 and died August 4, 1877 in Pettis County, Missouri. He married Mary Davis on January 5, 1822. They had seven children.

Joseph B. Spurgin born November 25, 1805 and died June 14, 1827.

Phebe Spurgin born September 26, 1808 in Rowan County and died in Saline County, Missouri on May 14, 1870. She married Jacob Ferguson on May 24, 1831. They had four children.

Elizabeth Brazelton Spurgin born October 21, 1811 and died October 27, 1823.

Jane Emily Spurgin born October 21, 1814 and died in Sedalia, Saline County, Missouri on April 27, 1895. She married Haley Brown on May 14, 1833. They had nine children.

JANE BRAZELTON born May 5, 1774 in Frederick County, Maryland, and died in McLean County, Illinois on December 29, 1833. She married John Maxwell about 1795. John was born in Maryland on July 25, 1765 and died in Illinois August 19, 1857. Their children were:

Mary Maxwell born June 29, 1796 and died in Daviess County, Missouri on January 29, 1873. She married Martin Scott on April 18, 1835 in McLean County, Illinois, and they had one son.

Nancy Ann Maxwell born June 29, 1796 and died in the 1840s. She married John Chatham in Orange County, Indiana on February 20, 1817. They had some seven children.

William Maxwell born November 28, 1797 and died February 26, 1839 in McLean County, Illinois. He married Theodocia Sanders on February 24, 1819 in Orange County, Illinois. They had five children.

Elizabeth Maxwell born January 30, 1800 and died April 22, 1848 in Orange County, Indiana. She married James Toliver in Orange County on June 19, 1821. They had eleven children.

Jane Maxwell born October 11, 1801 and died in Daviess County, Missouri on February 24, 1883.

Susannah Maxwell born in Ashe County, North Carolina on July 7, 1803 and died in Sonoma County, California on January 21, 1878. She married Thomas C. Cheney on March 4, 1830 in Tazwell County, Illinois. They had seven children.

Delitha Maxwell born September 12, 1805 in Ashe County and died April 14, 1885 in Daviess County, Missouri. She married Asher M. Jolly in Daviess County on April 27, 1873.

John Maxwell born August 18, 1807 in Ashe County, North Carolina and died January 5, 1891 in DeWitt County, Illinois. He married Elizabeth Scott July 17, 1834 in Sangamon County, Illinois. They had ten children.

David Maxwell born January 16, 1809 and died September 22, 1875 in Ogle County, Illinois. He first married a Mary in 1835 and they had six children. He later married Laura Gibler in Ogle County in 1871.

Lucinda Maxwell born January 16, 1809 and died March 11, 1831 in DeWitt County, Illinois. She married Martin Scott in Tazwell County, Illinois on February 26, 1830. There were no children.

Mahala Maxwell born March 14, 1811 in Asche County. She married William Lane in McLean County, Illinois on March 22, 1830. They had five children.

Obedience Maxwell born October 23, 1812 and died in 1901 in San Luis Obispo, California. She married Elbert Dickerson on May 12, 1831 in Tazwell County, Illinois. There were six children.

Phebe Maxwell born August 25, 1816 and died August 20, 1844 in McLean County, Illinois. She married Jeremiah Payne in McLean County on April 20, 1837. They had three children.

JOHN BRAZELTON 3rd born in Frederick County, Maryland on December 20, 1775. He married Sarah 'Sally' Bradley in Guilford County, North Carolina on December 11, 1790. They moved to Salem, Washington County, Indiana and to Vermilion County, Illinois. John died in Vermilion County on June 14, 1856 and Sally died there December 23, 1870. Their children were:

Rachel Brazelton born December 12, 1798 and died October 8, 1821 in Washington County, Indiana. She married Stephen S. Dunlap around 1818 in Washington County.

William Brazelton born in Guilford County on April 9, 1801 and died in Washington County, Indiana in the 1860s. He was married three times, first to Mary Skelton on November 28, 1822. She died in 1833 and he married Elizabeth Fultz on March 13, 1834. She died in 1847 and he later married Jane Evans on February 8, 1866. There were six children in the first marriage and six in the second.

John Brazelton born September 3, 1803 and died October 22, 1823 in Indiana.

Eli Brazelton born January 16, 1806 and died February 23, 1866 in St. Louis, Missouri. He married Lucy Gibson in Clark County, Indiana on March 1, 1827. They had one son.

Margaret Brazelton born July 5, 1809 and died in Iowa August 28, 1850. She married David Evans in Vermilion County, Illinois on May 23, 1839. They had two children. She had an earlier child out of wedlock surnamed Brazelton.

Jacob Brazelton born February 17, 1812 in Washington County, Indiana and died in Vermilion County, Illinois January 13, 1870. He married Rebecca Thornton on August 21, 1834 in Vermilion County.

Sarah Margaret Brazelton born August 16, 1814 and died after 1880. She never married, but still had two sons surnamed Brazelton.

Lydia Elizabeth Brazelton born March 27, 1817 in Indiana and died December 16, 1881 in Vermilion County, Illinois. She married Henry Elliott in Vermilion County on December 8, 1842. I do not think there were any children.

Phebe Brazelton born December 27, 1819 in Washington County, Indiana and died October 8, 1846 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She married a cousin William Brazelton in Vermilion County on November 28, 1836.

Elizabeth Brazelton born July 2, 1822 and died September 7, 1823 all in Washington County, Indiana.

ELIZABETH BRAZELTON was born in the 1770s. She married Peter Hunt January 3, 1816. I have no other information.

MARGARET BRAZELTON was born in the 1770s and died in 1842. She married Maskell M. Jester in Guilford County in 1801. Their children were:

Elizabeth Jester born in 1801. She married Lynch Ryals.

Rebecca Jester born September 25, 1803 in Guilford County, North Carolina and died in Davidson County, North Carolina in March 1845. She married William J. Bodenhammer on February 8, 1826.

John Brazelton Jester born in 1806 and died in 1879. He married Margaret Haworth November 1, 1827 and after she died he married Mary Alice Poore in Guilford County on February 9, 1854.

Margaret Jester born in 1808. She married Benjamin Elder on January 3, 1831.

William Jester born January 27, 1811 and died April 29, 1873 all in Guilford County. He married Sarah Iddings January 2, 1838.

Michael Jester born in 1813 and died in the 1850s in Surry County, North Carolina. He married Rachel Haworth October 13, 1839 in Guilford County. They had four children.

Phebe Jester

LYDIA BRAZELTON was born May 9, 1781 and died before 1859. She married Jesse Spurgin in Guilford County on December 24, 1800. Jesse was born in Rowan County on June 30, 1780. He died about 1860. Their children were:

Jane Spurgin born 1801. She married Daniel Snider.

Sarah Elizabeth Spurgin born March 31, 1803. She married David Winter April 10, 1828. She died December 10, 1869 in Douglas County, Nevada.

Agnes Spurgin born in 1805. She married somebody on August 10, 1828.

Samuel Spurgin born in 1807. He married ? on September 14, 1828.

John Spurgin born about 1809 and married Marinda Stagsdale August 23, 1828.

Lydia Spurgin born in 1811. She married ? July 31, 1851.

Lucretia Spurgin born in 1813. She married Noah Cotton May 21, 1846.

Ann Brazelton

Ann or Nan as she was called was born in Frederick County in 1744. She married Isaac Brown about 1761, and was widowed by 1788. She then moved into her father's house and he spent his last years with her.

Ann seems to have moved to Kentucky with others in the family and then on to Harrison County, Ohio where she died in the 1824 to 1825 time period.

The following were her children, all named Brown: **SAMUEL, DIANA, CHARLOTTE, SARAH, EMILY, GUILLEMENIA, ZIMRI, NATHAN, LUCRETIA, OLINA** and **LOSADA**.

Another source lists her children as: **RUTH, MARY, HANNAH, ELIZABETH** and **ELEANOR BROWN**. As I am not certain on this one, I'm holding off listing them here at this time.

Esther Brazelton

Esther was born July 24, 1748 in Frederick County. She married William Metcalf in 1766 in Frederick County.

They moved to Kentucky and she died in Hopkins County sometime after 1826.

They had ten children:

Jacob Brazelton

Jacob was born on June 27, 1749 in Frederick County, Maryland. He married Hannah Green in early 1772. He moved to Granville County, North Carolina. He served as a private in the North Carolina line during the Revolution. After the Revolution in the early 1790s, the family moved to the Pendleton District of South Carolina.

Although I am tracing the Brazelton family as a part of our Canaday History, it is interesting to note that while they were living in the Pendleton District, one of his daughters, Hannah, married my cousin Ezekiel Putman. A small world indeed in those days.

In the 1800 census the family was still in the Pendleton District although he was awarded land in Georgia as a result of his wartime service. Jacob subsequently moved to Jackson County, Georgia and settled on the Mulberry Fork of the Oconee River in what was to become Brazelton, Georgia, a town named after him. The area was by the Hall County/Jackson County line. The town of Brazelton remained *owned* by the Brazelton Family until 1989, when it was purchased by a group led by the movie actress, Kim Bassinger, a native of the area.

Jacob died September 22, 1825 in Brazelton, Jackson County, Georgia and is buried in the Walnut Church Cemetery.

WILLIAM BRAZELTON

William Brazelton was born January 12, 1734 in Baltimore or possibly Prince Georges County, Maryland. He moved to Loudon County, Virginia from Frederick County and became a member of the Quaker Church in March of 1758 at the Fairfax, Loudon County, Monthly Meeting in Virginia. At the same time he transferred to the Warrington Meeting in York, now Adams, County, Pennsylvania.

On October 28, 1758 at the Warrington Meeting House, he married Sarah Shepherd.

Sarah was born about 1735-36 in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and was a daughter of Solomon Shepherd and Jane Wilson. Solomon Shepherd came from Killaman, County Tyrone, Ireland and settled in Chester County, Pennsylvania in November of 1730. He was an indentured servant to Jacob Marshall and moved to Menallen Township of Lancaster, now Adams, County in Pennsylvania. He was reported as a minister of the Quaker Church at the Warrington Meeting in 1748. He married Jane Wilson on September 15, 1733 at the New Garden Meeting in Chester County. They had four children including Sarah.

William and his brother John bought *Black Oak Hill* and *Level Spring* in Frederick County, Maryland from his father and they settled there. In 1762, he moved to the New Garden Quaker community in Guilford County, North Carolina. He fought in the Revolution.

After the Revolution, he moved with his family to Greene County, now Jefferson County, Tennessee. This was about 1790. He remained near New Market, Tennessee until his death on September 2, 1827 at age ninety-seven. Sarah died in New Market in about August 1826 according to one source, and before 1790 according to another source.

William and Sarah Brazelton had eight children:

Sarah Brazelton

Sarah was born May 15 1762 in Frederick County, Maryland. She married David Saunders in Guilford County, North Carolina on May 21, 1783. David was born September 15, 1760 and was a son of Hezekiah Sanders and Martha Elmore Johnson. Martha's given last name was Elmore, but she was raised David and Mary Johnson.

Sarah died in North Carolina on August 13, 1821, David died there August 17, 1845.

David and Sarah Sanders had the following children:

SAMUEL SANDERS born March 17, 1785 and died July 22, 1821.

ELIZABETH SANDERS born June 20, 1786 and died May 29, 1844. She married Solomon Horney in Guilford County on February 20, 1812.

HEZEKIAH SANDERS born June 21, 1788.

WILLIAM SANDERS born March 20, 1790.

JACOB SANDERS born March 22, 1792. He married Sarah Hoover March 31, 1819 at the Whitewater MM in Indiana.

SARAH SANDERS born January 7, 1794. She married a Shields man in Guilford County in about 1814.

MARTHA SANDERS born August 13, 1796. She married Elias Elliott in Guilford County January 11, 1827.

JANE SANDERS born February 22, 1798. She married Davis Pegg in Guilford County on September 9, 1824.

DAVID SANDERS born October 30, 1801.

John Brazelton

John was born in Frederick County on July 8, 1764. He moved to North Carolina and there married Hannah Goodin in about 1785.

He moved to Tennessee and lived twenty miles west of Knoxville in Knox County, Tennessee. He then was one of the founding families of Harden County, Tennessee. He died there September 20, 1816. Hannah was still alive at the time, she died sometime in the 1820s, as she was in the 1820 census and not in the 1830 one.

Their children were:

ELLENDER BRAZELTON Nellie was born about 1793-94. She married John Thacker in Roane County, Tennessee August 28, 1811. She died June 30, 1868 in Hardin County.

SOLOMON BRAZELTON born about 1794 and died after 1860. He married Elizabeth Berry about 1820 in Harden County, Tennessee.

ELIZABETH BRAZELTON born about 1796 and died August 4, 1854.

BENJAMIN BRAZELTON born about 1798.

SARAH BRAZELTON Sally was born in Knox County in 1800 and died unmarried December 26, 1878.

NANCY BRAZELTON born in 1804 and died March 15, 1830.

WILLIAM BRAZELTON born in 1805 in Roane County and died July 23, 1886. He never married.

William Brazelton

William Brazelton was born August 2, 1766 in Guilford County, North Carolina. He was married twice. First to Elizabeth Lucus Pidgeon on May 10, 1787 in Guilford County. She was the daughter of John Lucas and a widow and was some ten years older than William. She died on February 8, 1828. William then married another widow, Abigail Morgan Bales (Beals) in Jefferson County, Tennessee on February 4, 1835.

William left North Carolina and went to Georgia for a period and then moved to the Lost Creek settlement in Greene, now Jefferson County, Tennessee where he lived for some ten years. He traveled to Illinois in 1834 and returned to Tennessee to marry Abigail. Within a few months, they moved to Vermilion County, Illinois and lived in Ridge Farm until his death on September 11, 1846. Abigail was born October 25, 1790, and died in Ridge Farm on November 5, 1863.

He had six children, all by his first wife Betsy. They were:

JACOB BRAZELTON was born in Greene County, Tennessee December 23, 1787 and died in Indianola, Warren County Iowa April 18, 1871. He married Margaret Carper on June 26, 1808 in Jefferson County, Tennessee.

LYDIA BRAZELTON born March 2, 1790 in Jefferson County, Tennessee and died in Vermilion County, Illinois March 9, 1856. She married Isaac Smith November 1, 1809 in Jefferson County, Tennessee.

WILLIAM BRAZELTON was born April 9, 1792 and died May 17, 1877, all in New Market, Tennessee. He was a Major General in the Civil War. He married Mary Porter Reese March 5, 1816. She was born in 1798 and died December 30, 1826. He later married Martha Allen Gillespie in Washington County, Tennessee on December 9, 1828.
