THE DUTCH PUTMAN FAMILY

Johannes Putman of New York

There are three major groups of families in America with the name of *PUTMAN* and *PUTNAM*. One English, one German and one Dutch in origins. This is a brief early history of the Dutch Putman family that descended from Johannes Pootman or Poutman who was born in the Netherlands and came to America in about 1659.

Most of the information contained here comes from several works. *The History of the Putman family in the Netherlands* written in 1736 by Adolph Hendrick Putman and translated by DeWitt C. Putman and found in of Eben Putnam's *Putnam Leaflets, volume 7*, May of 1899; *Genealogy of David Putman and his Descendants* written in 1916 by George W. Putman; *The Putmans of the Mohawk Valley*, found in the works of Eben Putman, *A History of the Putnam Family in England and America, volume II*, 1908; and from a compilation of information by Warren T. Putman written in 1989, *The Putman Family New York and Beyond*. Most recent information comes from the research of Warren Putman of Rio Linda, California and from Mark Putnam of Caro, Michigan. I am especially in debt to good old Warren.

A fair amount is known about Johannes or Jan Putman, but nothing is positive about his parents or his ancestors. From piecing together bits of letters and information gleaned by DeWitt Putman in the late 1800s, it appears that the earliest known forebearer of Jan Putman was one Rutger Putman, Jan's great grandfather.

I shall begin with this Rutger Putman, but am only certain when we get to the section on Johannes (Jan) Putman.

RUTGER PUTMAN

I have read that there were religious differences in England in the late 1400s and early 1500s, and that branches of the Putnam/Putman family left and traveled to Germany. It is quite possible that both the German and Dutch families that came to America might well be related to the English Putnams way back sometime. Who knows?

In his article, Adolph Putman states his great grand-father was Rutger Putman who was born in Hamm, Westphalia, Germany in 1510. Rutger was legal advocate for Count Van der Lyppe and he lived for many years in Lipstadt in Germany. He married Agnez Bosch in Lipstadt about 1535. It is not known how many children they had, but there is a fair amount of information on two of the sons, Abraham and John.

Rutger died in Lipstadt in 1575 at the age of sixty-five and Agnez died there in 1588. The following is information that I have on the two sons of Rutger and Agnes Putman.

John Putman

John Putman was born in Lipstadt in 1566. He studied theology and because of his beliefs, he had to leave Germany and settled in the Netherlands. He went to Markel and remained in hiding. He taught school for a period and then was named Pastor of the Church at Goor. He married Matilda Meyer, daughter of the mayor of Goor, sometime about 1585.

He was a prominent and influential clergyman in Goor. He died in 1658 at the age of ninety-four years. He is buried in the yard of the church at Goor and his name is cast in the church bell there.

John and Matilda had two sons, Rutger and Abraham.

RUTGER PUTMAN who was also a famous clergyman, and is of the line of Jan Putman. His life is contained in the next section.

ABRAHAM PUTMAN of whom I have little information except that he outlived his brother as he was the one who placed the burial stone over his brother. He also must have remained in the Netherlands all his life.

Abraham Putman

Abraham was born in 1567. He studied law and traveled to England during the Reformation in 1590. He died there in 1650. Not much more is known about this Abraham Putman.

RUTGER PUTMAN II

Rutger was born 1597 in Goor, Holland. Rutger followed his father's footsteps and became pastor at Weerselo and then later at his father's church in Goor. He married Joanna Vandenburg, a daughter of Paul Vandenburg of Amsterdam. He became pastor at Delden in 1634 and remained there for some forty years.

When he died in Delden in 1674, his son Paul could not obtain permission to bury him in the church yard, and he was buried in the Heyden cemetery. After peace was declared, Paul was able to place the remains of his father under the Pastor's chair in the church at Delden. A stone was placed over him by his brother Abraham.

Rutger and Joanna had three children that I have a record of:

Sarah Putman

Sarah married Joachim Liens, the Pastor at Friesenveen. Joachim was born in Zeeland.

Johannes Putman

Johannes was born in 1645 and is the subject of the next section. This John or Johannes was the immigrant to America.

Paul Putman

Paul was born in 1648. Paul married Alida Bogerink of Deventer. They were married in Delden

in 1684 by Pastor Rutger Putman. Paul became a Pastor and succeeded his father at the church at Delden. He was Pastor there for 48 years. Paul died on June 2, 1720 at the age of seventy eight. Alida died two years later also at the age of seventy eight. Their children were:

ADOLPH HENDRICK PUTMAN, who wrote the 1736 family history.

JOANNA PUTMAN who married Judge Carl Cramer.

MATILDA ALIDA PUTMAN

JOHANNES (JAN) PUTMAN

Jan Putman was the member of the family who came to America and was the forefather of the American branch of the Putman (Dutch) family. He was born in Delden in the Netherlands in 1645. In 1661, at age 16, he was apprenticed to Philip Hendrickse Brower of Albany, New York. He signed his own name to these papers after arriving in America.

He was apprenticed for a three year period on September 14, 1661. It was common in those days to become an apprentice in exchange for passage to America.

In 1662, he moved with Brower and was one of the early settlers in Schenectady, New York. Brower died in 1664 and Jan became a freeman.

Sometime in the early 1670s, Jan married Cornelia Brandt, a daughter of Arent Andres Brandt the Vice Governor of Renselaerwyck.

Jan was a Deacon of the Dutch Church and was a Justice of the Peace under the Leyster Administration. Both were very important positions at the time. He remained in Schenectady all his life. He owned considerable lands in the area. Years later, one of his sons sold some of the land and Union College was founded on that property.

On the night of February 8, 1690, the Indians made a surprise attack on the white settlers. Both Jan and his wife were killed in the Schenectady Massacre. He was forty five years of age at the time.

The Children of Jan and Cornelia Putman

In 1715 the following children of Jan and Cornelia are listed: Arent or Aaron, Marite, Victor, David, Cornelius and Catalyntje. The following is what I know of these children and their families.

ARENT (AARON) PUTMAN

Arent Janse Putman was born in Schenectady in about 1675. In 1708, he married Lysbet Akkerman (baptized in Kingston, Ulster County, New York on December 17, 1684). She was the daughter of Lodowyk David Akkerman and Janetje Jacobsje Blyck.

They sold their lands in Schenectady in 1709 and in 1713, he is listed as a weaver in Albany, New York. Sometime in the late 1720s, he moved with his family to the *Mohawk Lands* west of Amsterdam. He was still living there in 1754. He worked in this area as an Indian interpreter.

It is reported that he was killed about 1754 during an Indian raid at Currytown, Montgomery County, New York.

Arent and Lysbet had the following children. The first baptized in Albany, the rest in Schenectady.

Jannetie Putman

Jannetie was baptized June 12, 1709. On January 6, 1729, she married Thomas Harris in Schenectady, Albany County. Thomas was a son of John Harris.

They had at least one child:

FRANCYNTJE (Frances) HARRIS baptized on February 10, 1748.

Nothing more is known of this family.

Johannes Putman Jr.

Johannes or John Putman was born October 21, 1711 and baptized December 21, 1711 in Schenectady. He married Gertruyda Six. Gertruyda died in 1751 and Johannes was killed by Indians in the Revolution in 1776.

An account written by his grandson, Ernestus Putman of New Madison, Ohio, in 1829 states John and his son David were captured by Indians in 1776. The old man was killed and David held for three years until he was able to escape.

Their children were:

MARGARET PUTMAN born about 1743, christened April 24, 1743 at Fort Hunter, Albany County. She married Jacob Shook at Stone Arabia, Albany County on October 15, 1762. I have no information on any children.

ARENT (Aaron) JOHANNES PUTMAN was born June 13, 1745. He married Elizabeth De Spitzer February 21, 1772. She was a daughter of Ernestus Josephus De Spritzer, and was born April 23, 1754 and died May 18, 1796. Arent then married Catalina Van Schaick. Arent died August 1, 1830 and Catalina died December 22, 1836. The children, all with Elizabeth, were:

Gertruyd Putman born in 1772, christened November 21, 1772 and died January 17, 1835 in Schenectady. She married Aaron Jacob Schermerhorn in Schenectady on October 20, 1791.

Ernestus Putman born October 27, 1776 in Schenectady and died October 20, 1865 in Winchester, Randolph County, Indiana. He married Nancy Becker in Schenectady April 1, 1797. He went into Virginia and after Nancy died he married Elizabeth Gray in Shepardstown Virginia (now in West Virginia) on March 24, 1814. They moved to New Madison, Ohio in 1819 and lived there for 38 years. In 1857, they moved to Indiana. Elizabeth died there February 15, 1864. She was born in Londonderry, Ireland July 27, 1788.

Johannes Putman christened February 7, 1779 and died shortly thereafter.

Johannes Putman born September 1, 1780 and died in Rotterdam, Schenectady County on May 1, 1851. He married Magdalena Vrooman December 23, 1804. She was a daughter of Hendrick Vrooman and was born in 1787 and died December 16, 1830.

Barbara Putman born in 1783 and baptized March 2, 1783. She married Oliver Springer.

NANCY PUTMAN born and baptized in 1747. I have nothing more.

MARY PUTMAN baptized May 23, 1750. I have nothing else on her.

HENDRICK PUTMAN baptized July 26, 1752. He married Hannah Anguish, daughter of Jacob Anguish. He moved to Fort Erie, Ontario as he was a Loyalist during the American Revolution. He settled in Bertie Township, Welland County, Ontario, and died in Canada in about 1837. Their children were:

Aaron Putman born about 1774.

Hannah Putman born about 1775.

Mary Putman born about 1777. She married a Fish.

Elizabeth Putman born about 1788.

Johannes (John) Putman born about 1790.

Dorothy Jane Putman born about 1796. She married William Griffin in Canada.

Henry Putman born about 1800. He married Martha Crowder in Canada.

Jacob Putman born about 1803.

CATHERINE PUTMAN baptized 1753. She married George Kirk in about 1771. Their children were:

Johannes Kirk born May 26, 1773.

James Kirk born August 28, 1775.

Elizabeth Kirk born July 31, 1778. Died young.

Elizabeth Kirk born January 31, 1780.

SARAH PUTMAN born about 1754.

DAVID PUTMAN was born February 25, 1755 and was baptized May 18, 1755. He fought for the Americans in the Revolution and was captured by the British and held prisoner in Canada for some three years. In 1783, he married Catherine Vedder, daughter of Gerrit Vedder. They lived in Johnstown, New York. He died in early 1793 while cleaning a well. He had two children that I know of, and probably others:

Johannes Putman born in 1789.

Margarietje Putman born September 11, 1791.

Lodewyck Arentse Putman

He was born in 1713 and baptized November 14, 1713. He married Elizabeth Suits (Suttz) in 1742 in Albany. She was a daughter of Johannes Peter Suttz.

It is not know when Elizabeth died, but Lodewyck was killed in a British led Indian raid at Hale's Mills, near Johnstown in Montgomery County, New York along with his son Arent (Aaron) on May 21, 1780. Both are buried there. Lodewyck was a private in Col. Frederick Visscher's Tyron County Militia.

Their children, all born in Johnstown, Albany County, New York were:

DERRICK (RICHARD) PUTMAN born in 1746. He married Neeltje 'Nelly' Van Brocklin in Stone Arabia, Albany County on October 17, 1767. She was a daughter of Gysbert Gerritse Van Brackeln and Maria Simon Danielse Van Antwerp. Nelly was born July 10, 1749. He served as a Lieutenant in the Revolution, serving in the Company of Capt. J. J. Davis at the battle of Oriskany among others. He rose himself to the rank of Captain. He

died April 4, 1835 at age 85. Nelly received a pension of \$4.00 and she died at age 100 on February 20, 1849. They both died at Ephratah, Montgomery County, New York. Their children were:

Arent Derrick Putman born December 10, 1768 and died in Wasteneau County, Michigan in 1837. He married Alida Wilson in about 1792 in Stone Arabia, Montgomery County, New York.

Gysbert (Gilbert) Putman born February 9, 1770 and died of yellow fever in Illinois about 1820. He married Catherine Schall at Stone Arabia on January 1, 1795.

Cornelia Putman born December 8, 1773. She married Dr. John Hahn in Stone Arabia April 29, 1792.

Garret Derrick Putman born December 8, 1776 in Johnstown, Tyron County, New York and died April 8, 1869 at Warren, Herkimer County, New York. He married Catherine Ann Rynex about 1802.

Marya Putman born in 1777, christened October 12, 1777. She may have died young, or she may belong to another family. Not certain here.

Maritje Doritje Putman born September 12, 1779 in Johnstown. She married Jacob Miller in 1796 in Caughnawaga, Montgomery County. She died June 14, 1852 in Carthage, Jefferson County, New York.

Lodewick (Lewis) Putman born April 27, 1783 in Caughnawaga and died June 14, 1852 in Taylor, Wayne County, Michigan. He married Hannah Annatje Rudd in Caughnawaga on October 4, 1803.

John Derrick Putman born January 19, 1786 in Fonda, Montgomery County and died in West Amsterdam, Montgomery County on June 20, 1846. He married Annatje 'Nancy' Van Alstyne at Fonda on May 7, 1808.

Peter Derrick Putman born April 1, 1789 in Ephratah, Montgomery County and died April 2, 1855 at Ephratah. He married Maria Eacher at Caughnawaga on September 23, 1810.

Seyme (Simon) Putman was born March 15, 1792 and died three days later.

Seyme (Simon) Putman born July 28, 1795 at Caughnawaga and died October 28, 1871 in Great Bend, Jefferson County, New York. He married Maria 'Polly' Keller about 1814 and had another wife later.

ARENT (AARON) PUTMAN was born in 1746. He married Delilah Fisk at Stone Arabia on November 26, 1767. He was killed along with his father on May 22, 1780 at Hale's Mills in Montgomery County. There was one daughter:

Annatje Putman born July 16, 1777.

FREDERICK PUTMAN born about 1750. He married Catherine Pennell August 20, 1770 at Stone Arabia. Their children were:

Philip Putman born May 16, 1772. He married Jane Houck in Cayuga County, New York on May 25, 1806. Children were: **Cathy, John, George P.** and **Eleanor.**

Frederick Putman, Junior born about 1774. He married Margarieta Barnhardt in 1801.

Arent (Aaron) Putman born November 19, 1776.

Johannes (John) Putman born May 9, 1779.

Arent (Aaron) Putman born November 19, 1782. One of these has to be wrong.

Aevje (Eva) Putman born March 23, 1785.

ELIZABETH PUTMAN was baptized August 29, 1754. She married Adolph Walrath on

March 21, 1770 and then married Jacob Harris about 1773, and then Hans Yost Bellinger in 1775. There was one child in the second marriage that I have, but I am certain there were more:

Jannetje Harris born March 12, 1774.

MARGARET PUTMAN was baptized also on August 29, 1754. She married Amasa Stevens in 1776. Amasa was killed by Indians serving with the British in a raid on his house on May 22, 1780. Margaret married John Cairncross of Johnstown later on. She died in Johnstown in 1835. Children with Amasa were:

Lodewyck Putman Stevens born July 24, 1777.

Catalyntje Stevens born about 1780 and died December 22, 1836. She married Joseph Leach in Schenectady January 21, 1798.

JOHANNES LODEWYCK (JOHN) PUTMAN was born in Jamestown in 1759. His wife was Lucy and they were married in 1786. He died in Johnstown on November 25, 1811 and Lucy died there on February 13, 1825. Their children were:

Lodewick Putman born August 20, 1784 in Johnstown. He died in Wilmington, Will County, Illinois September 4, 1825. He married Sarah Miller in Johnstown on February 3, 1820.

Elizabeth Putman born in 1787. She married John Reeves October 25, 1810.

Ebeneazer G. Putman born August 11, 1788. He married Rebecca Frey in Johnstown September 23, 1813.

Hanna Annatje Putman born July 20, 1789. She married Gilbert Haggart in Johnstown on January 15, 1807. She died in St. Lawrence County, New York October 2, 1881.

Sarah Putman born in 1793. She married John D. McMartin, a physician in Johnstown.

Johannes (John) Garret Putman born December 25, 1794 in Johnstown. He married Rebecca Wells on April 2, 1818. He died September 19, 1864 in Walcott, Rice County, Minnesota.

Peter Johannes Putman born December 11, 1799 and died in Macomb, St. Lawrence County, New York on March 13, 1873. He married Mary Ann Mason in Montgomery County, New York on February 14, 1828.

HANNAH MARGARETHA PUTMAN was born January 27, 1765. She married Jacob Shew in Caughnawaga, Montgomery County on March 10, 1787. Jacob was a son of Godfrey Shew and Catherine Frey. He was born April 15, 1763 in Johnstown. She died in Evan's Mills, Montgomery County October 5, 1848. Jacob died there January 23, 1853. Their children were:

Godfrey Shew born in 1789. He married Elizabeth Becker.

Lodowyck Putman Shew born 1792 and died in Montgomery County on October 30, 1870. He married Pamela Van Ness.

Catherine Shew born May 4, 1794. She married Leman Becker.

John I. Shew born in 1797.

Aaron Shew born July 16, 1803.

Elizabeth Shew born December 7, 1805.

Jacob Shew Junior born about 1800-1806 died in 1833.

David Arent Putman

David was born about 1715 and baptized October 3, 1715. In about 1740 he married Elizabeth Lehr (Leer). David died in the Revolution in about 1781 according to one source.

Nothing more is known of these two except the names of their children. They were:

CATHERINE PUTMAN was born in 1742. She married Frederick Bellinger on October 28, 1766. He was killed in the Battle of Sharon during the Revolution on July 12, 1781. She later married her first husband's cousin, Peter Bellinger.

MARGARETHA PUTMAN born about 1743. She married David Winnie October 31, 1802 in Fonda, Montgomery County. He was a son of Franz Winnie.

JOHANNES DAVID PUTMAN born August 5, 1773 at Tribes Hill He married Catalina Winnie, another of Franz's children, on August 27, 1797. He moved to Cherry Valley in Oswego County, and remained there all his life. The children, all born in Cherry Valley, were:

Hannah Putman born October 20, 1779 and died in 1873. She married Mathew Winnie January 1, 1815. After his death, she married Jacob Aney.

Agnes Putman born about 1800. She married David Houghtaling October 21, 1822.

Catherine Putman born September 19, 1801 and died May 23, 1881 in South Valley, Oswego County. She married Daniel C. Winnie May 10, 1825.

Margaret Putman born January 14, 1807. She married Marman Keller August 3, 1830.

Francis Winnie Putman born July 27, 1810 and died July 11, 1885 also in Cherry Valley. He married Ann Lowe December 22, 1829.

Eleanor Putman born June 22, 1815 and died August 2, 1855. She married Adam Seeber February 12, 1833.

Alida Putman born May 15, 1818.

William Putman born in 1820 and died November 2, 1877. He married Perlina Brown.

VICTOR DAVID PUTMAN was born May 22, 1747 in Stone Arabia. He married 'Maria' Maritje Schell on November 9, 1773. They lived in Root township of Montgomery County. Victor died there on October 12, 1800. The children, all born in Montgomery County, were:

David Putman born March 1, 1783.

Lodowyck Victor Putman born May 1, 1785. He married Mary Shank in April 1799.

Aaron Victor Putman born in 1790 and died in 1874 in Prattsburg, Steuben County, New York. He married Mary 'Polly' Rose May 20, 1821 in Stone Arabia. He fought in the War of 1812, and was a blacksmith by trade. They moved to Prattsburg in 1832 and both lived to be 84 years old.

Philip Victor Putman born November 20, 1791 and died in Montgomery County August 19, 1859. He married Elizabeth Kring about 1823. He was a hatter and tailor by trade.

Abraham V. Putman born in 1793, and died in Manlius, Onondaga County April 27, 1873. He married Nancy Ann Van Alstine about 1822.

ARENT DAVID PUTMAN born about 1749. He married Delilah Fox November 26, 1780. They lived in Root township, Montgomery County. There were two children:

Annatje Putman born July 16, 1783.

Maritje Putman born June 20, 1785.

DAVID ARENT PUTMAN, Jr. born February 25, 1751. He married Catrinia 'Catherine' Ledder on July 24, 1774. He moved to Herkimer County, New York where he died August 14, 1824. Catherine was born August 24, 1756 and died April 26, 1827. She was a daughter of Peter Louis and Helen Lehrin or Ledder. Their children were:

Robert David Putman born May 18, 1775. He married Rebecca Davis in about 1792.

Elizabeth Putman born December 22, 1776. She married John Vosburg January 27, 1805.

Johannes Putman born March 27, 1779. He married Catherine Winnie August 27, 1797.

Catharina Putman born March 31, 1782.

Isaac Putman born about 1785.

Anna Putman christened June 20, 1787.

Magdalena Putman christened February 12, 1792.

LODEWYCK 'LEWIS' PUTMAN born December 10, 1752. He married Maritje Grietje 'Margaret' Hallenbeck. They remained in Montgomery County. The children were:

Johannes Ludwig Putman born in July 1785. He married Margaret Becker November 12, 1809. He served in the New York Militia in the Civil War, Margaret made a Widow's Claim.

David Putman born February 21, 1785. He married Hannah Lettis January 11, 1814.

Batche Putman she was born February 10, 1795.

GEORGE 'JURRY' DAVID PUTMAN born about 1758. He married Mary Ferguson May 23, 1779. The marriage records lists him as Jurry Putman. He died March 14, 1829 and Mary died April 28, 1848. I have a record of one son:

David Putman born March 17, 1785.

Cornelia Putman

Cornelia was born in 1717 and baptized on October 12, 1717. On August 1, 1734 she married Stephanus 'Stephen' Cromwell. Stephen was born March 6, 1709 in Albany. He was a son of Jacob Cromwell and Mary Phillips.

Nothing more is known except the names of some of their children:

ARENTE CROMWELL baptized January 13, 1745.

PHILIP CROMWELL born in 1746, baptized January 11, 1747.

JACOB CROMWELL

Maritje 'Mary' Putman

Mary was born about 1719 and was baptized on July 15, 1719 in Schenectady, New York. She was married on July 20, 1740 at Fort Hunter, New York to Cornelius Bowen also of

Schenectady. He was a son of Willem Bowen and Rachel J. Jonkers.

Their children were:

PETER BOWEN born about 1845.

RACHEL BOWEN christened April 17, 1748.

WILLIAM BOWEN christened February 10, 1750.

MARGARET BOWEN christened May 19, 1754.

MARY BOWEN christened January 30, 1756.

Victor Putman

Victor was baptized on April 29, 1721. He died young.

Sarah Putman

Sarah was baptized on July 5, 1724. Nothing more is known.

MARIETJE PUTMAN

Maritie was born about 1678. She first married Stephen Bedent about 1699. He died in the early 1700s and about 1702, Maria married Steven Mefoor.

There were three children in the first marriage and one in the second.

Maria seems to have died in the 1715 to 1720 time period.

The children were:

NICLAUS BEDENT born about 1700, baptized April 10, 1700.

CORNELIA BEDENT baptized May 29, 1701.

GERRIT BEDENT

ANNA MEFOOR baptized September 19, 1703.

VICTOR JANSE PUTMAN

Victoor or Victor was born in Schenectady in the late 1670s. He was married in Albany, New York to Grietje Mabie, a member of one of the wealthiest families in the area, a daughter of Jan Pieterse Mabie. The family was one of the original fifteen settlers of Schenectady.

In 1715, he is listed as a member of the Second Foot Company in Schenectady. He was listed as

a freeholder in Schenectady in 1720. In 1733, he was a Captain of a Schenectady Company in the Colonial Wars. He moved to the *Mohawk Country* in the Catskills prior to 1732.

He died April 19, 1756 at Mohawk in Albany County. Grietje died sometime prior to 1770.

The following are their children.

Cornelia Putman

Cornelia was baptized August 3, 1707. She married William Bowen on February 13, 1732. Their children, all baptized at Fort Hunter, New York were:

WILLIAM BOWEN batpized January 26, 1835.

VICTOR BOWEN baptized January 20, 1840.

RACHEL BOWEN baptized January 27, 1845.

Antje 'Ann' Putman

Ann was baptized April 25, 1709. She married Isaac Collier on March 6, 1733 in Schenectady. I have no information on any children.

Johannes 'John' Putman

Johannes was baptized October 21, 1711. George Putman, in his book, stated John married Anna Van Antwerp. Anna or Annatje was born in 1711 and died in December 1806. She would have been the daughter of Arent Danielese Van Antwerp and Sarh Jan Dirkse Van Epps of Schenectady.

It is felt that he was killed fighting in the American Revolution. Their children were:

MARGARET PUTMAN baptized April 24, 1743 at Fort Hunter. She married Victor J. Putman, a son of Jacob Putman in the late 1770s. Margaret died September 18, 1835, and Victor died April 13, 1837. Their children, and there may have also been daughters, were:

SIMON CORNELIUS GROOT born in October 1745, baptized November 17, 1745. He married Annatie Truax on September 3, 1769. He died in West Glenville, Schenectady County.

HESTER GROOT baptized November 24, 1751. She married Harman Campbell.

EVA GROOT born in August 1754, and baptized September 3, 1754.

CORNELIUS GROOT born in January, baptized January 27, 1757. He married Maria Bastiaanse in about 1781.

Johannes 'John' Putman

John Putman was born in February 1720 and was baptized March 18, 1720. He was killed in a fight in the French and Indians War on June 26, 1747 on Bush island in the St. Lawrence above Montreal, Quebec. He was one of the four white men killed in that action. The name was recorded as Johannes Pootman.

He married Annatje Pruyn, a daughter of Frans Pruyn, Junior and Annetje Margarita (last name not known).

Warren Putman lists five children, but as the last three were born long after John died, I don't trust this listing, and so won't put them down here.

Lowys 'Louis' Putman

Louis Putman was born in November 1722, and was baptized December 1, 1722. He married Sarah Arentse Van Antwerp on January 13, 1746. She was baptized September 29, 1723 and was a daughter of Arent Danielese Van Antwerpen and Sarah Jan Dirkse Van Epps.

They lived in Schenectady. Their children were:

CORNELIUS PUTMAN baptized June 14, 1747. He may have died young, I have nothing further.

SARAH PUTMAN baptized December 24, 1749. She died as a child.

ARENT L. PUTMAN baptized July 10, 1751. He married a French girl, Rebecca De Garmo on February 28, 1772. He died in Fonda, New York on August 1, 1830. Their children were:

Sarah Putman baptized October 17, 1773. She married Johannes Leonardson August 21, 1792.

John Putman born August 6, 1775, and died in Fultonville, Montgomery County August 23, 1854. He married Rebecca Schenk December 12, 1797.

Lewis Putman born November 17, 1777 and died in Montgomery County on June 12, 1838. He married Mary L. 'Polly' Schenk April 12, 1799.

Annatje Putman baptized April 9, 1780. She married William Clary on March 12, 1809.

Matthias Putman baptized November 4, 1781 and died in infancy.

Cornelius Putman baptized April 18, 1784.

Matthias 'Mathew' Putman baptized January 18, 1787, and died in 1875. He married Nancy Anna Vedder March 8, 1810.

Arent Putman born May 17, 1793. He married Lavinia Rice.

Ellen Putman born in 1795. She married Peter Vedder October 7, 1847 (?).

JACOMYNTJE PUTMAN baptized December 26, 1753. She married Cornelius Van Alstyne on October 7, 1769. He was a son of Cornelius Van Alstyne and Catherine Stevens.

JOHANNES PUTMAN born October 7, 1756. He married Elizabeth Veeder, born January 1, 1757. She was a daughter of Harmonus Croset Vedder and Tryntje Dirkse Heemstraat. He was a Lieutenant in the New York Militia. He was present at Burgoyne's surrender at Saratoga on October 17, 1777. He died November 25, 1811. The children were:

Jacomyntje Putman baptized August 17, 1783. She married John A. Clute.

Lewis Putman born November 20, 1784 and died in the early 1850s. He married an Annatje in 1810.

Harmon Putman born April 29, 1787 and died in Schenectady County on May 15, 1847. He married Margaret Wheaton about 1812.

Sarah Putman born and baptized December 9, 1788. She married Jacob Graff, Junior in Johnstown November 11, 1813.

Isaac Putman born November 27, 1790 and died as an infant.

Isaac Putman born March 17, 1796. He married Charlotte Spillman January 11, 1819.

Cornelius Putman born October 9, 1799 and died August 21, 1861 in Lainsburg, Shiawassee County, Michigan. He married Eliza Ann Johnson in Chenango County, New York on December 2, 1820.

SARAH PUTMAN baptized October 21, 1759.

Maritje Putman

Maritje was born in February and baptized March 14, 1724. She married Johannes Van Vranken on January 18, 1752. He was a son of Claas Gerritse Van Vranken and Geertruyd Johannes Pieterse Quackenbush.

I have information on two children:

JACOB VAN VRANKEN baptized February 9, 1753.

GEERTRUYD VAN VRANKEN baptized March 21, 1756.

Catalyntje Elizabeth Putman

Catalina was born May 4, 1726 and baptized June 5, 1726. She married Lodovicus (Lewis) Clement on June 21, 1748.

Lewis was born November 30, 1725. He was a son of Joseph Janse Clement and Annatje Jacobse Peek. He was a loyalist and they moved to Canada either when the Revolution broke out, or right afterwards.

Lewis died in Chautaugua County, New York in 1781. Catherine (Catalina) died in Ontario, Canada.

Their children were:

JOSEPH CLEMENT born October 24, 1750.

ELIZABETH CLEMENT

MARY CLEMENT

JACOMYNTJE CLEMENT born about 1755 and baptized March 9, 1755.

JOHN CLEMENT born December 21, 1759.

JACOB CLEMENT born November 18, 1761.

JAMES CLEMENT born July 14, 1764.

Jacob Putman

Jacob was born on July 6, 1728. He married Annatje Statts or Davis and was thought to be living in 1784 in Montgomery County, New York.

Their children that I have information on were:

GARRIT PUTMAN baptized February 20, 1752.

MARITJE PUTMAN born about 1764. She married John J. Kitts. Their children were:

Jacob Kitts born June 13, 1785.

Eva Kitts born February 8, 1791.

Elizabeth Kitts born August 11, 1793.

Catherine Kitts born October 9, 1796.

MARGARIETJE PUTMAN born June 9, 1765.

Margarita Putman

Margaret Putman was born January 13, 1732. On July 17, 1758, she married Jacob Van Vranken. Jacob was a brother of Johannes who married her sister Maritje 'Mary' Putman. Jacob was a son of Class Van Vranken and was baptized June 22, 1729.

They had these children:

CLASS GERRITSE VAN VRANKEN who was baptized February 15, 1761 and died July 20, 1837.

CORNELIUS VAN VRANKEN baptized October 11, 1767.

PETRUS VAN VRANKEN born July 18, 1773.

Aevje 'Eva' Putman

Eva was born on December 16, 1734 and baptized on December 22, 1734. I have nothing else.

Arent 'Aaron' Putman

Aaron Putman was born in July 1736, and baptized on July 31, 1736. He married Catarine (Clara) Vedder on April 18, 1863. Clara was baptized April 3, 1743. She was a daughter of Harmenus Croset Veeder and Tryntje Dirkse Heemstraat.

They lived in Schenectady. Their children were:

CORNELIUS PUTMAN baptized June 14, 1763 and died as an infant.

CORNELIUS PUTMAN baptized January 25, 1767. He married another Vosburg daughter, but I do not have her name.

CATHARINA PUTMAN baptized April 16, 1769.

JACOMYNTJE PUTMAN baptized on August 18, 1771.

CHRISTIAN CHESTER PUTMAN baptized October 7, 1774. He married twice, first to Cataline Peek on October 12, 1796 and second to Catalyn Bratt in the early 1800s. I only have information on these children:

Arent Putman born December 22, 1796 and died young.

Arent Putman born January 28, 1799.

CALEB PUTMAN born about 1779. He married Elizabeth Rynex on May 31, 1799. She was born in September 1771, a daughter of Andrew Rynex and Maria Smith.

Gysbert 'Gilbert' Putman

Gilbert was baptized on June 28, 1741. I have nothing else.

CATALYNTJE PUTMAN

Catalina was born about 1689. She married Cornelius Post in Schenectady on December 11, 1704. Cornelius was baptized November 6, 1683. He was a son of Elias Post and Maritie Jannetje Cornelise Egmont.

Their children were:

CORNELIA POST baptized September 2, 1705.

ELIAS POST baptized January 7, 1708. He married Maria Van Eps on November 7, 1730.

JOHANNES POST baptized September 24, 1710.

MARIA POST baptized May 25, 1713.

DAVID POST baptized April 22, 1715.

More information of later generations may be obtained in the writings of Warren T. Putman, Mark R. Putman, DeWitt Putman and George W. Putman. Warren and Mark have both done such a great job, I can get real lazy here, so that is why I have only gone this far in my work on this Dutch family.
