THOMAS PUTMAN

A son of Benjamin and Elizabeth Putman. Thomas Putman was born in Granville (then Bute) County, North Carolina in about 1780. In 1810 he appears in the South Carolina Census and living in York County. York County is just below Cleveland County on the North Carolina and South Carolina border. In 1810 Thomas Putman bought some 200 acres on *the waters of Bulls Branch* in York County. He sold this land on May 18, 1820. He obviously purchased other lands as he sold 777 acres also in the York District on April 20, 1819.

In the 1810 South Carolina Census, he is listed along with his wife, Fanna or more likely Hannah as she was called, two young daughters and one young son, all under the ages of ten years. They were probably married in York County around 1805. In the 1820 South Carolina Census he has four sons and four daughters. By the 1840 Census, he is living with his wife and three children in Rutherford County, North Carolina.

Thomas Putman had received a land grant in 1841 for 100 acres in Rutherford County, North Carolina. He later transferred this property and *The Mansion House* as a gift to his son, Elias Putman. This deed also gives the name of his wife as Fanna.

Thomas Putman does not appear in the 1850 census, so I assume that he died sometime in the 1840s while residing in Rutherford County.

Okay, in 2003 a relative sent me a will of a John Lindsey made in York County, South Carolina. In it he states his folks were Isaac and Rachel Lindsey. He goes on to mention names, including his 'brother' Thomas Putman, and later Hannah Putman. We are sure it should have been recorded as Thomas being a brother in law. If this makes sense, then Thomas Putman had married Hannah Lindsey in York County where her folks were then living. Sounds fine to me.

He had at least eight children according to the 1820 census, but I have only the name of one positive one, ELIAS, mentioned in the deed. The rest of the children I will try and place with Thomas are just guesses. The first three daughters may have been a Mary Putman born in 1808, Susan Putman born in 1810 and Manirva Putman born in 1813. I mention them only because they appear near Martin in Marshall County, Alabama in 1860. They may, in fact, belong to most anyone, so I won't actually list them here.

Martin Putman

Martin was born in 1807 or 1808 in York County, South Carolina. He remained there as a child and then in the late 1820s went with his parents back to North Carolina just over the border. In 1828 or 1829 he married Muhulda Parker. According to the 1850 census, she too was born in South Carolina.

In 1830 they were to first appear in the census of Rutherford County, North Carolina with a baby girl, Nancy. In about 1835 they moved to Marshall County, Alabama and then to Morgan County and in the 1850s back to Marshall County in northern Alabama. Martin was a Methodist

preacher.

Martin and the family remained in Alabama the rest of their lives. He was married two more times, to Jane Basham in 1871 and then to her sister Dorcas Basham in 1880. He died on May 19, 1882. For more information on this family see the section on ALABAMA PUTMANS.

Their children were:

NANCY PUTMAN born in 1830.

FRANCES PUTMAN born in 1832.

JAMES WINSTON PUTMAN born in 1834. In 1880 he was in Marshall County, Alabama and was married to Elizabeth Guire.

THOMAS PUTMAN born in 1837.

SARAH JANE PUTMAN born in 1839. She married Jesse Young.

SUSAN PUTMAN born in 1841.

JOSEPH F. PUTMAN born in 1843. His wife was Margaret, they were married about 1883.

WILLIAM THOMAS PUTMAN born in 1846.

JOHN G. PUTMAN born in December 1848. In 1880 in Marshall County, Alabama, his wife was Patricia or Patia. In 1900 they are in Burleson County, Texas and in Oklahoma after that.

MARTIN MARION PUTMAN born April 9, 1850. His wife was Mary E. Mabry.

CHAMPION FARRIS PUTMAN born in 1853. He married Louisiana (Lucy) Roberts in 1872, and in 1880 they were in Marshall County, Alabama and in 1900 they were in Webster County, Mississippi.

Wilson L. Putman

Wilson was born in about 1814 in South Carolina. He married Millie or Emily Cole on April 22, 1839 in Rutherford County, North Carolina. He appears there in the 1840 Census.

By the 1850 Census he is in Haywood County, North Carolina. He is 36 and Emily 32. At the time they had the following children: HUGH 10, LOUISE 7, SYLVANIA 6 and THOMAS 2.

I haven't found any listings in 1860 nor 1870 for him.

By the 1880 census of Haywood County, Emily has died and he has a new wife. He is 67, Elizabeth is 40 and with them are MONTVILLE 15 and EDWARD 10, the rest have moved on I

guess. In 1880 there was an ELIAS PUTMAN living next door, and was a son born just after the 1850 census. Elias was 26 and his wife Margaret baker was 23.

The children were:

HUGH PUTMAN born in 1840. He has a wife Martha in the 1870 and 1880 Haywood County, North Carolina census. There were no children shown in either census.

LOUISE PUTMAN born in 1843.

SYLVANIA PUTMAN born in 1844.

THOMAS COLE PUTMAN born in April 1848. He married Amanda Singleton in Haywood County in January 1880. In 1900 he is in Haywood County, North Carolina with his wife Amanda and these children. In 1910 he is 62 and widowed, I don't find him in 1920. The children were:

David Luther Putman born April 15, 1880. In 1920, he is in Haywood County with a wife named Bertha L. Fry. They were married February 15, 1902, he was 21 she was 15. In 1920, they had these children:

Nellie R. Putman born in 1904.

Mary M. Putman born in 1906.

David Luther Putman Jr. born in 1910.

Maud E. Putman born in 1913.

Ruth V. Putman born in 1916.

Nellie E. Putman born in 1920.

Benjamin Putman born in March 1882. Don't find him in 1910.

John Putman born in November 1891. Don't find him in 1910.

ELIAS PUTMAN was born August 9, 1850. He married Margaret Ellen Baker in Beaverdam, Haywood County on November 12, 1874. They were together in the 1900 census, but she must have died shortly afterwards. Elias married Elizabeth Presley on December 7, 1902, he was 52 and she was 45 at that time, second marriage for both I would assume. Elias died February 4, 1935 according to his death certificate. The children, all with Margaret, were:

Florence Lavinia Putman born 1876.

Mary Ellen Putman born July 7, 1877. She married Charles W. Presley of Haywood County. She died April 20, 1940. Charles was born October 4, 1879 and died August 17, 1953. This is according to their tombstones.

Robert Coleman Putman born October 6, 1879. He married Florence Roxy Stamey on August 7, 1904. They lived in Haywood County all their lives. Roxie died there July 1, 1952 and Robert died on April 18, 1955. Their children were:

Rixie Virgil Putnam born August 28, 1905, and died June 16, 1985. He married Annie Keykendall, and later married Edith Meleda Hampton on May 29, 1946

Audrey Putnam born in 1909. She married E. Theo Ford.

Dawson (Doyce M.) Putnam born in 1912. He married Hazel Shuler March 7, 1936.

Ola Putnam born in 1914.

Dewey Wilson Putnam born in 1917.

Mattie Putnam born in 1919.

Luches Vaudney Putnam born after 1920, as were the following kids.

Lucille Putnam married Manson Messer.

Vera Putnam married Lewis Conrad.

Velma Putnam married Robert Scott.

William Wilson Putman born August 23, 1883, and died December 8, 1957. He married Cordelia H. Stamey on August 1, 1909. She was born August 9, 1888 and died May 11, 1921. He is in Haywood County in 1910 and 1920 with Cordelia and these children:

Eva Flora Putman born March 5, 1910, and died April 4, 1976. She married John T. Rhodarmer. He was born August 24, 1884 and died November 21, 1957. Again, this is from cemetery records.

Jane or **Jennie Putman** born in 1911.

Martha Louise Putman born in 1912.

Donald Arthur Putman born May 13, 1913 and died June 7, 1956. His wife was Alice.

Rufus Harden Putman born January 6, 1888. He married Hester Presley on December 17, 1909. In 1920 he and Hester are here and have these children:

May Putman born in 1912.

Ethel Putman born in 1914.

Rufus Putman born in 1916.

Edith Putman born in 1917.

Mary Putman born in 1919.

Joseph W. Putman born December 1889 (or 1890). He married Cora M. Presley on November 20, 1910. In 1920 he and Cora had these children:

Ernest E. Putman born in 1912.

Hazel L. Putman born in 1914.

Gladys B. Putman born in 1915.

Thomas E. Putman born in 1917-18. There is a tombstone of an Earl Putman born May 6, 1918 and died April 25, 1923. This may be him.

Henry G. Putman born in April 1891. He is not at home in 1910. BUT, there is a marriage record of George Putman marrying Elizabeth 'Lizzie' Messer on March 24, 1912. At that time his age was listed as 20 so this would seem to be him. All this assumes his middle name was George, but everything else fits. I don't find him in 1920 at any rate.

JOSEPH WILLIS PUTMAN born in October 1856. He too is in Haywood County in 1900 through 1920. He married Matilda Conrad in 1881. They had at the time, these children:

Walter Putman born in May 1882. He married Elizabeth 'Lizzie' Kerley on October 19, 1906 and is gone by 1910. There is a record of a Lizzie Putman marrying William or Willie Putman in 1913 and she had a daughter born in 1907 in the 1920 census. This leads me to believe Walter died or something. No clue.

Sallie Putman born in September 1883.

James Putman born in September 1885. He married Linda Price on July 27, 1906. Like his brother, he is gone by 1910. In 1910, there is a Linda Putman living with her 'folks' Matt and Rhoda Franklin. I assume this is her and her mom had remarried. If this is the case, James died about 1908 or 1909. Children with Linda in 1910 were:

Esther Putman age 2.

Callie Putman age 1.

William Putman born in January 1893. In 1920 in Haywood County he has a wife named Elizabeth four years older than himself. There is a marriage record of a Willie Putman marrying Lizzie Putman (must be a kinfolk's widow) on February 8, 1913. I am guessing she was Lizzie Kirley, widow or whatever of Walter Putman (see above). At any rate William and Elizabeth were here in 1920 with these children:

Bertha Putman born in 1907. Obviously from Elizabeth's first marriage.

Fred Putman born in 1917.

Gene Putman born in 1917, a twin.

Frederick P. Putman born May 5, 1896. Still home in 1920.

Frances Putman born in January 1900. She married Mark Putman on April 10, 1917.

MONTVILLE A. PUTMAN was born in 1865. He married Mary Lou Conrad in 1888. She was a daughter of George Conrad and Sarah Williams. She was born in July 1869. A relative said she used the nickname 'Sidi.' Mont died in the 1890s. In 1900, Mary is living with her brother in law, Joseph W. Putman. She then married George Grimes or Grooms and is with him in 1910. George lives right next door to Joseph and Matilda Putman. The children seem to be:

Lilly Putnam born in May 1888. She is living with her grandfather George Conrad in 1900 and in 1910 she is with her mother and new husband George Grimes or Grooms. She has a 3 year old son, **Charley Putman** with her. Not sure what this is all about, don't know why they use the Putman name, maybe she never married. Charley is probably James' son.

George Wilson Putman born December 16, 1889. In 1900 he is listed as a grandson of George Conrad. I don't find him in 1910, but I do find a Mark (Mont?) Putman living as a nephew of Wilburn Conrad. Since there is an age difference, I believe they are separate folks. He married Mary Ethel Wright about 1917. Ethel was born May 11, 1896. Their children were:

Lucy Mae Putnam born April 26, 1918. She married a Franklin.

Ethel Putnam born March 14, 1920. She married a Downs.

Virgil Lowery Putnam born February 25, 1921.

Montville Millard Putnam born June 9, 1924.

Laura Putnam She married a McCraine.

Loretta Putnam born July 24, 1926. She married a Head.

Janice Putnam married a Silvers

William Horace Putnam born June 23, 1932.

Mark Putman born in 1893. I don't find him in 1900, but in 1910 he is with his uncle, Wilburn Conrad. There is a marriage record of Mark Putman marrying Frances Putman on April 10, 1917. Frances was a daughter of Joseph W. Putman. I do not find them in 1920.

Elizabeth Putman born in December 1894. She is with her mom in 1900.

EDWARD M. PUTMAN was born in about 1870. He married Robena Emiline Brock in 1890. He died in 1897, and Robena appears as a widow in 1900. Then things get a little messed up, as in 1910 Robena has four new kids all named Putman. She is still around and without a husband in 1920. She seems to have remarried a Wyatt guy for the time span of 1900 to about 1906, divorced and went back to her old name. Here are the kids, they may or may not all be Putmans, but the seem at least to be Robena's. A descendant says her fully name was Armindy Emmaline Brock.

Jessie Putman a daughter born in March 1893. In 1900 she is with Robena and again there in 1910. She was married or at least gone by 1920.

Effie Putman born in May 1885. She is with her mom again in 1910.

William Hobart Putman born January 19, 1897. In 1900 he is living with Andy and Emma Wyatt and listed as a son. In 1910 he is listed as Herbert and is living next to his mother Robena, and is listed as a nephew of Charles Gillang. In 1920, he is in Spartanburg County, South Carolina and listed as a stepson of Mark and Eunice Inman. He married Nellie Dorman in South Carolina and worked there in the textile industry. He died in Blacksburg, South Carolina April 30, 1977. I have a copy of the death certificates of both Hobart and Nellie with listings of their children. The Emma Wyatt, and the 'Eunice' Inman seem to be Robena, who I now find went by the name Emma. I know she married Mark Inman, not sure about the Andy Wyatt connection though.

Clarence Putman born in 1903. He might be the Robert listed with Robena in 1920.

George Putman born in 1903. He is with Robena in 1920.

Annie or Annabelle Putman born in 1905. She is with Robena in 1920.

Verda Putman born in 1907. She is with Robena in 1920.

Elizabeth Putman

Elizabeth was born in about 1818 and she married Joseph Cole, I assume a brother of Emily, on March 18, 1839. Joseph was a son of Hugh and Mary Cole.

Their children were:

MARY ANN COLE born November 22, 1840 and died September 1, 1913. She married William Zachary Taylor GRIFFIN, son of George and Martha GRIFFIN, 30 Sep 1869 in Rutherford Co., NC. Born 1849 in NC. Died 1927 in SC. Buried in Mt. Zion Baptist Church Cemetery, Spartanburg Co., SC.

FRANCES E. COLE born 1844 in NC. Died 1919 in SC. Buried in Mt. Zion Baptist Church Cemetery, Spartanburg Co., SC. She married William Watson 'Watt' Collins

THOMAS LANDRUM COLE born 7 Jun 1845 in NC/SC, and died 11 Aug 1918 in Rutherford Co., NC. Buried in Pleasant Grove Methodist Cemetery Rutherford Co., NC. He first married Mary Elizabeth Grose, daughter of Hoyle Grose & Susan Harrill, 28 Jul 1872 in Rutherford Co., NC. She was born 8 Nov 1850 in NC/SC, and died 25 Aug 1883 in NC. Buried in Pleasant Grove Methodist Cemetery Rutherford Co., NC. They had the following children:

Zedock Putman

Zed was born in about 1823 in South Carolina. He first appears in the 1870 census of Marshall County, Alabama with a wife named Margaret. He is then listed as Zeddie Putman age 47, Margaret C. Putman is 32 born in Tennessee. It appears that Margaret's last name is Mabry, as with them is Mary Mabry age 17 who will marry Martin Marion Putman, a son of Zed's brother Martin Putman.

By the 1880 census of Marshall County, Margaret is listed as a widow at age 42. This is their last listing.

There was only one child:

ZEDOC LINA PUTMAN born February 6, 1875 in Marshall County. In 1900 he lists himself as Zediah Putman. By 1910, he is still in Marshall County and has a wife named Mary Susan born in 1887. He and Susan are still there in the 1920 census. Based on census reports, their children through 1920 were:

Elias Putman

Ah yes, yet another Elias Putman. This one is the only child that I am positive is a son of Thomas Putman. He was the youngest son and as all his siblings were off on their own, his dad left him the *mansion house* and lands as mentioned at the beginning.

Elias was born July 13, 1824 in Rutherford County, North Carolina. He married Mira Hughes there March 31, 1847. Mira was born March 6, 1828. They were both still in Rutherford County in 1880, he 55 and she 50. Still at home were Harriett 17 and Samuel W. 13. In 1900 Elias and Mira were still alive at 75 and 70 and living by themselves.

Elias died in Rutherford County on November 9, 1901, Mira died there January 17, 1908. They are buried at the Kistler Chapel Methodist Church Cemetery in Shiloh, Rutherford County.

THOMAS Y. PUTMAN born March 4, 1848. He married Sarah Jane Robbins on January 26, 1865. Sarah Jane was a daughter of John Robbins and Olattia Hay. She was born August 26, 1849 in Rutherford County. They were still in Rutherford County in 1900 and 1910. Thomas died March 16, 1916. In 1920 Sarah was living with her son William (Billy). Sarah died March 20, 1927. Both are buried in the Shiloh Baptist Church Cemetery. Their children were:

James A. Putman born September 1870, and married Margaret Jane Owens on January 15, 1888. Margaret was a daughter of Joseph Owens and Susan Roach. She was born in Rutherford County on April 7, 1870. They were in the 1900 through 1920 census of Rutherford County. I do not know when James died, but Margaret Jane died September 24, 1964. Both are buried in Holly Springs Baptist Church Cemetery.
