The Daughters of Reverend John Putman

NANCY PUTMAN

Nancy was born about 1807-1808. In 1824 or 1825, she married Fielding Turner and they moved north to Spartanburg, South Carolina. In the 1850 Census she appears by herself as Nancy Turner age 50. In the same area was a Fielding Turner, age 54, with a wife named Martha. Perhaps they were divorced, at least that's the way it appears to me.

ALICE PUTMAN

Alice married Edward Turner in the early 1820s. This family also went to Spartanburg. In the 1830 census there were 5 children under 10 and then 5 much older children. This may have been Edward's second marriage.

CASSANDRA PUTMAN

Cassie Putman was born about 1799-1800. She married in the early 1820s to Jesse Browning and they lived in Union County, South Carolina. They had 5 youngsters by the 1830 census report.

The family then moved to Attala County, Mississippi. Cassie died there August 26, 1858 and Jesse on June 2, 1873. Both are buried at Hal Brunt Place near Koskiusko in Attala County.

Children were:

SAMUEL BROWNING born about 1825.

HESTER BROWNING born May 21, 1826 in South Carolina and died in Attala Mississippi. She married Alexander Watson December 17, 1854.

HIRAM BROWNING born September 6, 1827. He married an Elizabeth.

SARAH ANN BROWNING born October 23, 1828. She married William M. Crosby and moved to Yell County, Arkansas.

SOLOMON BROWNING born February 18, 1830.

DORCAS BROWNING born about 1830. She married James P. Atkinson.

GREEN B. BROWNING born about 1832. He married Eliza Stanrod.

ELIZABETH BROWNING born October 10, 1835. She married Jack Atkinson.

MARTHA BROWNING born about 1836 in Atlanta Georgia where the family lived for awhile. She married Andrew Jackson Bain.

SANFORD BROWNING born September 16, 1838.

RUFUS L. BROWNING born September 30, 1842 in Atlanta. He married Sallie Fondren.

SUSANNAH PUTMAN

I have no information on Susannah or Susan Putman.

ELIZABETH PUTMAN

Betsy Putman married Stephen McPherson and remained in Union County.

EDITH PUTMAN

Edith married Fielding Clayton and they raised two daughters in Spartanburg and then moved to Mississippi. She died in Marshall County, Mississippi.

JANE PUTMAN

Jane married Nathan Harlan in about 1812. He was born in 1785 and died in 1834, and was a son of Samuel Harlan and Sarah Breed. They had a daughter, Louisa Ellen, born in 1815 in Union County. They had 5 children by the 1820 census of Union County. They moved to Fayette County, Tennessee in the 1830s.

HESTER PUTMAN

Hester married Lecil Bobo in Union County. They were in Franklin County, Tennessee in 1830 and in Coffee County, Tennessee in 1840. They moved to Anderson County, Texas in 1848. There was a report in the Daily Texarkana Newspaper on September 25, 1886 stating that the Hon. Lecil Bobo, former state senator of Monroe County (Arkansas) died in San Antonio, Texas a few days before.

SARAH (SALLY) PUTMAN

I have no information on Sally Putman.
