

JAMES PUTMAN South Carolina to Mississippi

James Putman was born about 1782 in Culpeper County, Virginia. He went with his family to Abbeville County, South Carolina and there married Elizabeth Johnson in about 1801.

He moved south to Mississippi and was in the 1830 census of Copiah County and was likely there a number of years earlier, as several of the daughters were married in Mississippi before 1820.

He remained in Copiah County and died in Mississippi in the late 1830s.

Elizabeth went 'west' with a son, probably Jeremiah or John, after her husband James died.

James and Elizabeth had nine children:

John James Putman

John was born in 1819. He married Nancy Crittendon in Copiah County on March 24, 1837. This date was taken from the Mormon IGI records. He was out of Mississippi by 1840.

I then find him in the 1840 census of Lafayette Parish, Louisiana and in the 1850 census of Livingston Parish, Louisiana. I do not find the family in 1860.

In 1850 John is 31, Nancy 29 and they had these children:

LURITAN (?) PUTMAN a son born in 1838 in Mississippi.

JAMES J. PUTMAN born in 1840 in Louisiana.

WILLIAM F. PUTMAN born in Louisiana in 1844.

SARAH F. PUTMAN born in 1848.

LOREN or **LURENA PUTMAN** born in 1850.

Jeremiah E. Putman

Jerry Putman was born January 6, 1802. He married an Elizabeth (possible last name of Harper) in the late 1820s around 1827. Elizabeth was born in Kentucky on May 15, 1809. They appear with two young daughters in the 1830 census of Copiah County.

He moved to Scott County by 1840. He died in Scott County, Mississippi in January of 1860. Elizabeth was shown as a widow in 1860.

They had twelve children.

LOUVINIA PUTMAN born March 29, 1828.

LOUISA PUTMAN born May 24, 1829.

SARAH JANE PUTMAN born March 16, 1831.

MIRANDA PUTMAN born September 19, 1833. She married Oliver H. Parker and moved to Texas.

CASSANDRA 'Cassa' PUTMAN born January 1, 1836. She married George Turner Sharp in the early 1850s. They moved to Kleberg County Texas in about 1869 and then to Madison County, Texas. They had ten children, seven born in Mississippi and three in Texas.

MARTHA ANN PUTMAN born December 17, 1837.

WILLIAM JEREMIAH PUTMAN born December 8, 1839. He was married by 1860 with a wife named Louisiana. In 1880 he had 7 children shown in the census.

ANDREW JACKSON PUTMAN born February 12, 1842. He died in the Civil War.

ALBERT GALLATIN PUTMAN born September 2, 1845. He married Charlotte McKnight on February 1, 1866. In 1880 he was in Scott County and they had 6 children shown.

DUDLEY N. PUTMAN born January 17, 1848 and died before the 1860 census.

MILTON FRANKLIN PUTMAN born June 1, 1849. He married Mary Jane Steed and lived in Scott County, Mississippi.

JEREMIAH PUTMAN Junior born December 25, 1851. He married Sarah V. Steed on February 19, 1880. They too lived in Scott County.

MARY E. PUTMAN born March 18, 1854. She married Joseph Rushing in late 1870. He was a Baptist minister. They spent their lives near Harpersville in Scott County. Mary Edna died September 24, 1896. Joseph later married Jannie Patrick on December 22, 1897. He died April 2, 1935.

Miriam Putman

She married Milton Smith, and died in Alabama.

Mary Putman

She married William Raiford, and lived in Mobile, Alabama.

Cynthia Putman

She married a Watts man and moved to Louisiana.

Neta Caroline Putman

She was born October 13, 1818. She married James Robert Crawford and remained in Mississippi. She died in Tryus, Lawrence County on December 26, 1886.

Calfenia 'Callie' Putman

She was born in Georgia in 1809 and died in Walnut Grove, Mississippi in November 1899. She married Andrew McDaniel, and later married David Clark January 3, 1826 in Copia County, Mississippi. David was a son of William Clark and was born in 1803 in Kentucky.

Their children were:

HENRY IRVIN CLARK born in Hinds County, Miss. May 16, 1827, and died December 29, 1893 in Scott County. He married Mary Seaberry in 1850.

WILLIAM CLARK born April 28, 1829 in Hinds County and died November 16, 1899 in Damascus, Mississippi. He married Annie Roberts, then Martha Caroline Finley February 5, 1851 in Walnut Grove.

GREENBERRY CLARK born in 1831, and married a Mary.

ELIZABETH CLARK born in 1835. She doesn't seem to have been married.

HENRY JACKSON CLARK born June 30, 1837 in Leake County, Miss. And died March 13, 1877. He married Evaline Sarah Ford.

JEREMIAH E. CLARK born in Leake County in 1839. He married Mary Dixie Ford in Scott County.

ALFRED CLARK He was born April 17, 1843 in Leake County and died in Sabine Parish, Louisiana June 17, 1915. He first married Virginia F. Hobbs and later married Eliza Wiley in Natchitoches, Louisiana January 26, 1879.

JOHN F. CLARK born April 17, 1843 and died May 2, 1918 in Natchitoches, Louisiana. He married Eleanor Jane Funderburk August 30, 1866.

WADE CLARK born in 1845.

NANCY CLARK born in 1847, and married Aaron Hinson.

JANE CLARK born in 1849.

Lucy Putman

She married Benjamin Hicks on July 19, 1829 and died in 1834.

Susan Putman

She married Neil McGill in Wayne County, Mississippi in 1818. She died in Mobile Alabama in 1834.
