WILLIAM PUTMAN

Abbeville & Laurens County South Carolina

William was the eldest son of Daniel and Sarah and was born about 1767 according to his tombstone, in Virginia. In early 1790, he moved to Abbeville County and was accepted in the Turkey Creek Church there on May 14, 1790.

He married Dulcybella Watkins in South Carolina about 1790 or 1791. She was born in 1769. He remained in Abbeville until 1814 when he moved back to Laurens County where he remained. They raised a family of nine children. William died in Laurens County on August 30, 1827 and is buried in the Warrior's Creek Cemetery.

William and Dulcy Putman had the following children:

Drucilla Elizabeth Putman

Elizabeth was born June 1, 1793. She married Stephen Garrett on September 9, 1811 and died in Chattooga County Georgia on December 25, 1861.

She was Stephen's second wife. Stephen Garrett was born April 16, 1775. He was a son of Edward Garrett and Ann Owsley. He was first married to Mary Eleanor Taylor about 1798 or 1799.

They moved to Georgia in 1842 where they remained. Stephen died January 25, 1845. In 1850, Elizabeth, then 56 years old, was listed as head of the household. She died in Chattooga County Georgia on December 25, 1861.

Based on the 1850 census records some, if not all, the children were as follows. The first five children were by Stephen's first marriage, the rest were with Elizabeth. His first wife was a Moore.

SILAS A. GARRETT born about 1800 in Laurens County and died October 9, 1882 in Springfield, Keokuk County Iowa. He married Elizabeth D. Cheatham in Montgomery County Kentucky December 3, 1817. Elizabeth was born in Montgomery County March 1, 1891 and died in Keokuk County Iowa May 1, 1880. She was a daughter of John Cheatham and Mary Harper from Virginia. They had eleven children. She was born in Illinois October 20, 1830 and died in Elk Creek, Lawrence County South Dakota. They had at least 13 children. Milton Denver Garrett born in Montgomery County May 29, 1822 and died in What Cheer, Iowa October 24, 1862.

Eliza Jane Garrett born in Montgomery County December 18, 1824 and died in Delta, Keokuk County Iowa April 21, 1905. She married Caleb Reynolds December 20, 1840 in Morgan County Indiana. Caleb was born in Tennessee December 20, 1821 and died in Delta, Keokuk County Iowa April 12, 1903. They had some eleven children. Robert Garrett born in Kentucky May 12, 1827 and died in What Cheer, Iowa April 25, 1874. He married Nancy Jane Pence November 20, 1847. She was born July 2, 1830 in Kentucky. They had three children before she died there April 8, 1854. He then married her younger sister Elizabeth Pence in 1855. Elizabeth was born March 28, 1833 and died December 9, 1908 in Delta, Iowa. Mary Ann Garrett born in Mooresville, Morgan County Indiana October 7, 1829 and died in Waurika, Jefferson County Oklahoma.

James Henry Garrett born in Mooresville, Indiana March 16, 1832 and died in What Cheer, Iowa January 15, 1921. He married Susan Crocker November 23, 1852 in Salina, Jefferson County Iowa. She was born in Huntingdon, Pennsylvania July 15, 1835 and died in What Cheer Christmas Day 1914. They had eight children. Andrew Prater Garrett born March 22, 1836 in Indiana and died in What Cheer April 5, 1918. He married Hester Ann Crocker November 23 1856 in Jefferson County Iowa. She was a sister of Susan Crocker who married James Garrett. She was born in Pennsylvania August 7, 1837 and died in What Cheer on Christmas Day 1919. Her sister died on Christmas Day 1914. Elijah L. Garrett born in Indiana June 10, 1840 and died in Delta, Iowa August 18, 1903. He married Susan Elizabeth Hasty October 31, 1861 and they had eight children. She was born in Morgan County Indiana June 12, 1842. After Elijah died she returned to Indiana and died there in Greenwood, Johnson County on February 25, 1925. GREENBERRY GARRETT born May 2, 1813. He married Permilia Robertson about 1833. She was a daughter of Toliver Robertson and Sarah Moore born about 1815. He died in Chattooga County Georgia in 1875. Their children were:

Matilda Garrett born in 1835 and died in July 1875. She married Jabez Henson Floyd about 1858. He was born July 23, 1834 in Coweta County Georgia and died in Comanche County Texas February 24, 1890. SILAS A. GARRETT born September 25, 1830. He married Elizabeth D. Cheatham. They went to Iowa.

BENJAMIN GARRETT born April 6, 1833. He became a physician. I don't know if he married, but he died in 1863 in Georgia, most likely in the Civil War.

LUCINDA 'LUCY' GARRETT born July 23, 1837 and died in 1858. She never married.

Henry Putman

Henry was born in 1795. He married Sarah Moore in Abbeville. Sarah was born March 15, 1793 and was a daughter of Robertson Moore and Kiziah Garrett. They were married about 1812 to 1813.

He died in Laurens County on August 10, 1816. Sarah died there December 14, 1842. I have a record of one daughter born before Henry suddenly died:

PERMELIA PUTMAN born in 1814 and married to Greenberry Garrett. See above listing, Greenberry was a son of Stephen Garrett and Elizabeth Putman.

Mary Putman

Mary was born September 15, 1800. She married Reuben Putman, a son of William Putman and Mary Mitchell of Union County South Carolina. Reuben was born in 1796.

They moved to Texas in about 1837 and Reuben died about 1839 in Washington County Texas. Mary was there in the 1840 and 1850 census and died November 20, 1860 while in Gonzales County Texas.

ELIZABETH PUTMAN was born in about 1837. She married M. F. Hayes on June 3, 1856 in Washington County Texas. That's all I have.

Amelia 'Milly' Putman

Milly was born May 28, 1798. She married Edward H. Garrett. Edward was a son of Jesse Garrett and Elizabeth Henderson. He was born May 21, 1795 in Laurens District.

They were listed in the 1840 Laurens County census with four sons and five daughters. They moved to Georgia and were in Chattooga County Georgia in the 1850 census.

She died July 13, 1866, Edward on July 19, 1875 in Colbert County Alabama.

They were in the 1850 census of Chattooga County and in 1860 in Calhoun County Alabama. Their children were:

MAYBERRY GARRETT born in South Carolina in 1816 and died December 5, 1836 in Laurens County.

WILLIAM P. GARRETT born in 1825 in Laurens County and died July 9, 1863 in the Civil War in Vicksburg, Mississippi. He and his wife Martha had these children:

Amelia Ann Garrett born in Calhoun County Alabama in May 1860 and died in Lamar County Texas July 26, 1913.

ELIZABETH GARRETT born in South Carolina about 1826 and died in Piedmont, Alabama in 1897. She married Francis Grogan January 13, 1846. He was born April 13, 1814 and died May 18, 1868. They had 6 children:

Augustus W. Grogan born in June 1852 in Chattooga County Georgia and died October 27, 1922 in Etowah County Alabama. He married Ruth Margaret Clay.

Octavia Grogan born in Chattooga County Georgia and died in Jacksonville, Calhoun County Alabama in April 1932.

Louisa A. Grogan born March 5, 1857 and died in Atlanta, Georgia August 2, 1932. She married Francis Marion Greenwood April 23, 1893 in Calhoun County Georgia. He was born in Georgia June 26, 1844 and died December 10, 1902 in Calhoun County Alabama.

Jefferson Davis Grogan born in Chattooga County in March 1860 and died in Calhoun County Alabama in December 1930.

Angela Grogan born about 1862.

Amanda Grogan born about 1864.

REBECA JANE GARRETT born about 1830 in Laurens County.

MALINDA M. GARRETT born February 14, 1833 in Laurens County and died in

Piedmont, Calhoun County Alabama October 25, 1909. She married John H. Price about 1875. He was born in Tennessee October 18, 1832 and died in Calhoun County Alabama January 27, 1900.

SANFORD V. GARRETT born in 1836 in Laurens County. He died in the Civil War in Fredericksburg, Virginia in 1861.

ALBERT GARRETT born in 1838 in Laurens County.

WILEY JESSE GARRETT born July 22, 1842 in Chattooga County. He moved to Calhoun County Alabama. He died there May 5, 1913. He married Frances Martin about 1868. Fannie was born in Cross Keys, De Kalb County Georgia October 7, 1840 and died in Calhoun County Alabama January 30, 1918.

Nimrod Putman

Nimrod was born March 20, 1801. He married Sarah Dollar Waldorp about 1825. She was born about 1802 and died in Laurens County in 1857. He then married Rachel Halk or Haulk who died in 1873. He died in Laurens County on July 28, 1876.

He had ten children, all by his first wife, Sarah.

EMELINE PUTMAN born in 1827 and married January 28, 1847 to Lelander P. Rogers.

DAVID PUTMAN born February 17, 1828 and died October 18, 1898. Not sure on this guy.

ARRINDA PUTMAN born in 1829 and married January 16, 1851 to Joseph Burdett. She was widowed by 1870. Joe was probably killed in the Civil War in the early 1860s. She had two children, both single at home in 1870 and 1880:

Martha E. Burdett born in 1854.

H. Pierce Burdett born in 1859.

HILLEN P. PUTMAN born in January 1833. He and his brother, Sanford, are in Colorado County Texas in 1860, living with Henry and Nancy Robertson from South Carolina. He is single and 27 at the time. In 1870 he is still in Colorado County married to a Julia and has four children. In 1880 he is in Cherokee County Texas with another wife, Sarah, and 5 children. He is still there in 1900. He seems to have married several times. First to a Julia in the 1860s. Then to Louisa C. McKinney on August 14, 1873 and then to Sarah Ann Waggoner on December 3, 1874. Hillen died in Mixon, Cherokee County Texas in 1908 and Sarah Ann died there in 1912. The children were:

Martha Ann Putman born in 1862. She was at home in the 1880 census. She married George McWilliams in Cherokee County on July 14, 1880. They lived on part of Hillen's farm in Mixon, Texas. Their children were:

James Williams married a Jessie in 1901.

Hillen Putman born in 1865. Not in the 1880 census.

Monroe Putman born in 1866. At home in 1880. He married Lula Belle Wallace in Cherokee County on December 31, 1890. Lula died November 11, 1891 leaving a two

week old daughter. Her parents raised this daughter. Monroe next went to Cherokee County Texas and was there in 1900 and 1910 with his second wife Lenora Bassinger. In 1920, they were in Houston, Harris County Texas. The daughter was:

Bertie Mae Putman born October 20, 1891 and died May 6, 1965. She married W. E. 'Charlie' Pierce on December 23, 1908.

Sally (Sarah) Putman born in 1867. At home in 1880.

Willie Adeline Putman born in 1877. She married William H. Williams April 14, 1898. They moved to Houston, and William simply left home around 1915. Willie then married a Belcher who soon died and then married Mitt Hurst. Willie died in 1968 in Dayton, Liberty County Texas. Not counting various stepchildren, their daughter was:

Gladys Almeda Williams She married Harry Percy Breland in 1916.

James Putman a twin of Willie born in 1877. He died as a young child.

SANFORD PUTMAN born in 1834. He was 25 when he was in the 1860 Texas Census with his brother. The National Archives list him as enlisting as a private in Company A, 5th Texas Cav. on August 17, 1861 at Columbus, Texas. He fought and was wounded at the Battle of Valverde, New Mexico in early 1862. He died a short time later in Socorro, New Mexico.

WILSEY R. PUTMAN born in 1836. He was in Bell County Texas in the 1860 census. He died July 28, 1864 in the Battle of Deep Bottom, serving in the CSA troops.

LEANDER W. E. PUTMAN born in July 1840. He married a Sarah. I have a copy of a letter written in 1894 from Leander to Miles Dollar. In it he gives some information on the family that I am using here. It was in this letter that I found out about Reuben the brother of Nimrod. They were in Laurens County in 1880 and Enoree, Spartanburg County South Carolina in 1900. In 1910 Sallie is a widow age 59 living with her son Jessie in Greenwood County South Carolina. I do not find her in 1920. Based on those census reports, their children were:

Mary Olla Putman born May 29, 1877 and died September 27, 1964. She married James Perry Hammond.

John Rivington Putman born in August 1879. His wife was Annie born in November 1879. They are in Spartanburg County in 1900 and Greenwood County in 1910. In 1920, John is in Greenwood County with a new wife named Bessie four years younger than he. Children through 1920 were:

Pauline Putman born in 1903.

Grover Putman born in 1905.

Lucille Putman born in 1908 and seems to have died by 1920.

Vivian Putman born in 1911.

Sybil Putman born in 1917, probably a child with Bessie.

Sallie Authie Putman born in November 1881.

Carrie Ader Putman born in April 1884.

Bernard Putman born in 1924.

Dorothy Putman born in 1928.

Essie Lee Putman born in February 1887, the other twin, a girl.

Hillim Jerome Putman born in December 1891. I don't find him in 1910 or 1920.

AMANDA PUTMAN born in 1842 and married Milford Robertson.

MILAM PUTMAN born in 1844. He died of disease in a CSA hospital in 1861.

PURCHASE PUTMAN born June 11, 1847 in Laurens County and died there May 11, 1918. She married Joseph Harrison Owens about 1875. He was born October 5, 1851 and died in Laurens County July 6, 1894. They had:

Perry Herbert Owens born November 17, 1878 in Youns, Lauren County and died in Laurens, Laurens County March 10, 1933. His wife was Bertha, born about 1883. They had two children Irene and Guy.

Ethel Owens born in 1882 and died in 1917 all in Laurens County. She married Fed Thomas Hughes about 1900. He was born in October 1880 and died in 1912 all in Laurens County. They had three children: Wayne born in 1901, Joseph Chestley born in 1905 and Jessie born in 1908.

Milum Oswell Owens born January 13, 1884 and died in Darlington, South Carolina in December 1880. He married Jessie Estelle Hammett. She was born in Georgia in September 1888 and died in Charleston, South Carolina December 1, 1953. They had two sons Millum and Joseph.

JULIA PUTMAN born May 9, 1848 and died in Laurens County June 9, 1920. She married William Lafayette Garrett in 1873. He was born December 14, 1850 in Laurens County and died there May 18, 1926. They had:

Oscar Garrett born September 3, 1874 and died October 19, 1887 in Laurens County.

Minnie Garrett born in June 1877.

Lola Garrett born in June 1880 and died in Cook County Illinois November 16, 1967.

Edgar Garrett born in November 1882.

Lidia Ann Garrett born September 24, 1886 and died in Laurens County April 22, 1976. She married Ernest Posey Howard. He was born January 30, 1886 and died in South Carolina November 17, 1914. They had two children:

Nellie Olean Howard born January 14, 1908 and died in Clinton, Laurens County March 6, 2002. She married Paul McCauley.

Oscar Posey Howard born January 5, 1911 and died in Moncks Corner, South Carolina in September 1968. He married a Sumpter gal in about 1935, then Hazel Elizabeth Edwards in August 1940 and then a Pabst gal in about 1943. All ended in divorces. He was in the Air Force as a career and was a research scientist for them.

Sarah 'Sally' Putman

Sally was born about 1806, married Reuben Dollar in Laurens County and died in Morgan County Alabama.

Reuben died in 1849 and Nimrod settled the estate in Laurens County.

Sarah is listed in the 1850 Morgan County Alabama Census. With her are these children, all born in South Carolina. Also living with her is William Dollar, age 60. William was Reuben's older brother.

Their children were:

WILLIAM P. DOLLAR born in 1825.

SAMUEL DOLLAR born in 1827.

REBECCA JANE DOLLAR born in December 1830. She married a Fairclothe.

HENRY DOLLAR born in 1833.

SOPHY DOLLAR born in 1837.

MILAS DOLLAR born in 1840. He never married and was living in Perry County Missouri in 1894.

John Calhoun Putman

John was born in Laurens County in 1808. He married Nancy Ellen Garrett about 1837, and they were in the 1840 census of Laurens County. In 1850 they are in Blount County Alabama where he is 41, Nancy 37 and they had their first five children.

By 1860 things went a tad downhill for John. Instead of listing himself as a farmer, he listed as a day laborer and his two oldest sons, Reuben and Henry, were working on a neighbor's farm. But, he had two more children by then. The 1860 census showed John, James and George as being born in Georgia, but 1850 showed them born in Alabama. I really don't feel he moved to Georgia and then back to the old farm.

In 1870 he is still in Blount County Alabama with a farm again and one more daughter. In 1880 he is still in the county at age 66 and Nancy is 60.

I assume they died by 1900 as they were not in that census.

SUSAN PUTMAN born in 1842 in South Carolina. She married James W. Abbott August 3, 1876.

DULCEBELLE PUTMAN born in Alabama April 5, 1847. Dulcy married Isom Chamblee January 10, 1883.

JOHN WESLEY PUTMAN born in January 1848 in Alabama. He married Milly Angeline Holly January 19, 1871. They remained in Blount County Alabama through the 1900 census report.

JAMES E. PUTMAN born in Alabama in 1850. He married Eliza Alice Rutherford in Blount County Alabama on November 8, 1877.

GEORGE WASHINGTON PUTMAN born in Alabama in 1853. He married Dicy Jane Sandlin in Blount County in 1874.

JOSEPHINE PUTMAN born in Alabama September 9, 1861. She married William M. Rutherford in Blount County in 1882.

HENRY PUTMAN born in 1839. Not listed after 1850.

ALBERT PUTMAN born in 1843. Not listed after 1850.

ZELIA C. 'ZANEY' PUTMAN born in May 1842 and married to Zodic Van Garrett. In 1900, they had:

Conway Garrett born February 1879.

SARAH PUTMAN born in 1848. She *might* be the Sallie Burns living with Pedon's widow in 1910.

PEDEN PUTMAN born in 1849. He married Nancy Jane (Griffin?). He has died by 1900, but Nancy is in Laurens County with these children. She is in Greenville County in 1910 at age 70 living with Rufus Waldrop who was widowed. I assume he married Mattie:

Mattie J. Putman born in November 1876. Probably married Rufus Waldrop.

James Griffin Putman born March 19, 1877. In 1900 he has a wife named Mary and a son. In 1920 they are in Greenville County with:

James Earl Putman born October 4, 1898.

Albert L. Putman born in November 1880. I don't find him in 1910 or 1920.

JANE PUTMAN born in 1854. She married William Andrew Nelson.

IRBY DUNCAN PUTMAN born June 14, 1859. In the 1900 Laurens County Census, his wife is Laura E. Ball born April 9, 1867. Irby died in Greenville, South Carolina May 27, 1930 and Laura died in Laurens County July 29, 1919. They had these children:

William McDuffie Putman born July 30, 1886. In 1920 and 1930 he is in Greenville County with a wife named Minnie Lee and no children listed.

Robert J. Putman born June 23, 1897. I don't find in 1920. Possibly still in the army.

Benjamin Albert Putman born September 23, 1900 and died November 14, 1918.

Ludema B. Putman born in 1903. She married William Stepp in 1923 and is in Greenville in 1930 and has her dad with her.

Dollie T. Putman born in 1906.
