MADISON PUTMAN

of LLANO COUNTY TEXAS

Madison DeKalb Putman is a son of Simeon Putman and Peggy Mercer and a grandson of the Reverend John Putman and Sarah Howard of Union County South Carolina. The story of John is in the **SOUTH CAROLINA** Section. Simeon's life is in the **KENTUCKY** Section. Madison's life is contained here. Madison DeKalb Putman derived his middle name from the Bavarian Mercenary General that his grandfather, John Putman, served under during the Revolution, Baron Johannes DeKalb.

Madison Putman was born in Monroe County Kentucky on August 6, 1809. He moved with his family to Hamilton County Tennessee in the mid 1820s and then in the early 1830s moved to Randolph County Alabama. He married Catherine Olivia Davidson either there or in Benton County Alabama on March 26, 1835. Catherine was born in Georgia on January 11, 1817.

In about 1846 after Texas became a Republic, he came to the Robertson Colony in what is now Williamson County Texas. In 1851, he received a grant in east Llano County Texas and moved there. He later acquired land in southwest Llano and remained there until his death in 1882.

He first lived on a farm on Pecan Creek some 22 miles southeast of Llano, Texas. From a letter I find that the land in southwest Llano was owned by an Alvin Schneider and currently by Harold Preston and the original log house still is standing, though not used.

During the Civil War, Madison moved his family into Comanche Indian Territory to avoid being taken into the Confederate Army. He was a supporter of the Union.

There is a wonderful story in the March 1924 issue of the *Frontier Times Magazine* concerning a 1864 hunting trip that 'Cal' as he was known and his son Harve made up the Upper Llano and how they were attacked by Indians. Both were wounded, dad seriously. Harve went for help and both were saved by neighbors in the area. It was stated this wound ultimately caused 'Cal' Putman's death over a decade later.

Madison Putman died on April 21, 1882 and Olivia died on July 25, 1899. Both are buried on the family ranch in southwest Llano County. The cemetery as well as the old cabin is still standing today.

The children of Madison and Olivia Putman were:

John Washington Putman

John was born on August 2, 1837 in Randolph County Alabama. He married Telitha Cumi Casner in about 1859. She was a daughter of Martin and Jane Casner and was born in Alabama in 1838 or 1839.

He and Cumi lived in Loyal Valley, Llano County until about 1872 when they moved to

Gatesville, Coryell County Texas where he remained.

Cumi died sometime between February 1876 when Edward was born and the time the 1880 census was taken where John appeared as a widower. He died in Del Rio, Val Verde County in about 1896.

Their children were as follows. The Llano County Courthouse burned in 1892 and all records prior to that were destroyed. Without marriage records, most of the wives are listed by first names used in the various census returns and so it is hard to give a clearer picture.

LAURA JANE PUTMAN. She was born in 1860 in Llano County. She married a Mitchell and moved to California.

SILAS B. PUTMAN. Si was born in Llano County December 10, 1861. His wife was named Nettie. He died in Houston, Harris County Texas in 1940. In 1900 and 1910 he is alone in Dallas. They had two sons. It appears that Silas and Nettie were divorced, as in 1910 the two kids are with their mom and are stepsons of John Cronin in Bryan County Oklahoma. In 1920, the kids are in Houston, living near their dad. Silas died in Houston May 9, 1935. The two sons were:

Fred B. Putman born December 13, 1890 and died in Dallas October 31, 1956. He married Minnie Hunt and later Ruby Warnke. Ruby was born May 10, 1895 and will die May 24, 1988.

Edward D. Putman born March 22, 1892 and died in Travis County Texas May 11, 1967. He married Emma Blalock. She was born in Harris County Texas October 26, 1893 and died there in Houston, Harris County September 22, 1961. In 1920 he and Emma are living with his brother Fred in Houston. In 1930 they are living there by themselves.

MARION DANIEL PUTMAN. He was born in April 1864. He was known as Dan. He was in Prescott, Arizona widowed in 1910 through 1930. I never find him with a wife, but there is a grave marker in Prescott of a Florence Hicklin Putnam who died there July 6, 1906. I would guess she was his wife. He died while prospecting in the desert near Blythe, California on August 15, 1939.

NETTIE OLIVIA PUTMAN. She was born October 31, 1866. She married John Tallie Guynes in 1885. He was born in Mississippi in March 1864. Nettie died in Corsicana, Navarro County December 6, 1909. They had:

Mabel Maude Guynes born in August 1886 and died in Baylor Texas on December 15, 1963.

John Tallie Guynes Jr. born June 19, 1892 and died in Albuquerque, New Mexico in May 1968. He married Anna Viola Sheets about 1909. She was born February 27, 1892 and died in Tijeras, New Mexico in November 1967. They had

Vivian Guynes born about 1910.

Marguerite O. Guynes born about 1912.

John Tallie Guynes III born October 25, 1914 and died in Jefferson County Texas November 26, 1963.

Dorcus T. Guynes born about 1916.

Maurice J. Guynes born about 1919.

Thelma Guynes born in August 1895 and died in Harris County Texas September 9, 1980.

SARAH JOANNA PUTMAN. Annie was born June 6, 1867. She married George Clyde Earwood on January 6, 1889. She died on February 13, 1957 in Del Rio, Texas. Clyde was born in Lavaca County Texas November 17, 1865 and he died in Del Rio, Texas February 2, 1950. Joanna lived to be 90 and you'll notice most of her kids did as well. Good Genes ☺ Their children were:

Ada Earwood born January 9, 1886 in New Mexico and died November 20, 1979 in Sonora, Sutton County Texas. She married James A. Cauthorn January 6, 1907. He was born in Missouri February 11, 1873 and died in Sutton County May 5, 1967.

Bertha Earwood born September 1, 1887 in Junction, Texas and died in Del Rio, Val Verde County Texas on November 8, 1979. She married Calvin R. Word.

Raymond H. Earwood born in Kimball County Texas on April 4, 1889 and died in Del Rio, Val Verde County January 28, 1975. He married several times, a Lois and Mattie Brooks (married on January 1, 1914) and I think some other gal. Mattie was born in Texas about 1890 and died there June 3, 1943.

Ollie Houston Earwood born May 21, 1891 and died August 8, 1919.

Fred Thomas Earwood born April 13, 1893 in London, Texas and died in Sonora, Sutton County Texas on November 18, 1968. He married Mary Annette Amer November 1, 1920. She was born May 4, 1898 and died October 21, 1992 in Sonora, Sutton County Texas.

Elsie Earwood born January 29, 1895 and died in Del Rio, Val Verde County March 27, 1985. She married Byron Earl Wilson in 1917. He was born in Texas about 1883 and died in the early 1950s.

Marye Earwood born April 6, 1901 and died June 4, 1980. She married Glynn Don Pass.

Lloyd C. Earwood born April 6, 1901 and died June 4, 1980 in Sonora. He married Mary Dan Wilson on February 4, 1929.

Macye Annette Earwood born January 13, 1906, and died February 12, 1984 in Del Rio, Val Verde County. She married Gilbert Cottrell Marshall in San Antonio on November 12, 1925. He was born March 9, 1890 in Boone Count Illinois and died in Del Rio January 29, 1984 two weeks before Macye did.

WILLIAM M. PUTMAN. He was born in Llano County in 1869. He died in Ellensburg, Washington. I don't have any more information on Will.

MINNIE LAVINIA PUTMAN. She was born August 8, 1870, the last child born in Llano County. She married James Brown Manning on March 7, 1889. He was born in Hamilton County Texas September 28, 1867 and died there February 5, 1913. They moved to Oklahoma where she died February 25, 1909 in Ryan, Johnston County Oklahoma. They had:

Emma Manning born in December 1889. She is missing or married by 1910.

John B. Manning born in May 1892 and died in Ryan, Johnston County Oklahoma February 16, 1909.

William E. Manning born in October 1893 in New Mexico and died in Ryan, Johnston County Oklahoma

Patrick Uel Manning born May 18, 1895 in New Mexico and died in Alameda, California. He married Selma Irwin. She was born in 1898 and died October 17, 1960.

Roy L. Manning born in January 1897 and died in Hamilton County Texas August 15, 1909.

Albert D. Manning born November 16, 1898.

Simon Manning born in October 1899.

Hilrey William Manning born September 16, 1903 and died in Oklahoma.

QUINNIE CUMI PUTMAN. She was born May 26, 1874 in Coryell County. She married John Horn Walters on September 14, 1890. He was born in Texas in about 1861. She died in Vivian, Louisiana in November 1960. They had:

Silas E. Walters born February 11, 1895 and died in Vivian, Caddo County Louisiana July 15, 1968.

Ethel F. Walters born about 1896.

Homer Walters born about 1898.

John L. Walters born about 1900.

Claud Walters born about 1908.

EDWARD HUGH PUTMAN. He was born February 14, 1876 in Coryell County. He married Mary Corrine Allsup on March 4, 1896. In 1900 he was alone in Ward County Texas. He was shot by a Texas Ranger on December 6, 1906 in Del Rio, Texas. It seems he was a sheep rustler. His picture is in a book titled *Album of Gunfighters*. They had one child:

Georgia Eloise Putman born October 16, 1897 in Christoval, Texas and died October 28, 1974 in Brady, McCulloch County. She married Silas Alee Wooten on December 25, 1919. Silas was born in Texas about 1895. They had:

Juanita Wooten born in 1920.

Silas A. Wooten born in 1924.

John Washington Putman later remarried to Levena 'Lee' (Childress) Quigg in the mid 1880s. She had been previously married to a Quigg man. They then moved clear across the state to Del Rio in Val Verde County Texas on the Mexican border. Here they had two sons. Lee died in 1891 and John in 1896, both in Del Rio.

The two children in the second marriage were:

DANIEL ISAAC PUTMAN born August 2, 1886 in Comanche, Texas. He married Cora Olive Culpepper on August 20, 1911 in Juno, Val Verde County Texas. Cora was born in Lavaca, Texas on January 12, 1887. Daniel died in Paris, Lamar County Texas on August 26, 1946. Cora died in Lebanon, Boone County Indiana on November 26, 1964. They had four children:

Elva Zora Putman born June 20, 1912 in Del Rio and died August 28, 1936 in Sumner, Lamar County Texas.

Harvey Isaac Putman born September 24, 1916. He married Marion Louise Summers on August 10, 1940. Marion died September 4, 1982 and Harvey November 27, 2005. I have info on one son:

David Lynn Putman born August 8, 1948 in Corpus Christi. He married Katherine Ann Janek in Dallas January 20, 1970. They had three children: David Shawn Putman, Stephanie Lyn Putman, Daniel Paul and Kenneth Allen Putman.

Ida Corrine Putman born April 15, 1919. She married Donald Raymond Rutherford on September 24, 1942 in Idabell, McCurtain County Oklahoma.

Lynn Putman born August 20, 1924 in Lamar County and he married Novalene Mercedes Fuller on July 26, 1942 in Paris, Texas.

JOHN WASHINGTON PUTMAN JR. was born January 10, 1895 and died in Del Rio, Val Verde County Texas on April 28, 1930. He is probably the John W. Putman living as a ranch hand in Bosque County Texas in 1920. He was single at that time, and was single when he died in Del Rio.

Margaret Susan Putman

Susan was born January 29, 1839 in Randolph County Alabama. She married George Scott in about 1855. George was born in Osage, Missouri December 16, 1832 and died in Los Angeles, California March 28, 1920. They divorced or separated around the early 1870s and he moved away. They had 5 children.

She then married Frank Moody about 1875 and they had four more children. Margaret died in Mason County Texas on January 29, 1892.

The children were:

SAVANTHA SCOTT born 1858 and died in Houston, Texas in 1945.

GEORGIA SCOTT born 1860 in Mason County. She first married Calvin Williams and later a Getz. She died in 1939 in Altadena, California. The children were:

IDA SCOTT born 1863. She married Green Flowers. They lived in Oklahoma City. Their two children were:

KATHERINE 'KATE' OLIVIA SCOTT born March 23, 1868. She married John Byrd on November 18, 1884 and died February 27, 1956 in Oklahoma City. Their children were:

Ethel Estelle Byrd born November 24, 1885 and married S. Weldon Morrison on February 5, 1905. She died December 2, 1979 in Rochester, New York.

Maude Mae Byrd born August 3, 1888 in Plano, Texas and died May 15, 1975 in Los Angeles, California. She married John McGibony.

John Homer Byrd born December 10, 1890 in Vernon, Texas and died October 17, 1961 in Oklahoma City.

Bera Idell Byrd born April 8, 1892. She married Walter Ridpath in Edmond, Oklahoma on August 5, 1913. She died June 4, 1969 in Oklahoma City.

Maggie Olivia Byrd born January 29, 1895 and died in Oklahoma City on December 13, 1972. She married Charles Dome on August 3, 1918.

Vada Velma Byrd born November 24, 1897 in Greer County Oklahoma. She married Charles Donovan on November 16, 1924 and died in Oklahoma City on June 29, 1979.

Clifford Patrick Byrd born in Greer County on March 26, 1900 and died in Oklahoma City November 29, 1975. He married Mayme Marshall in 1935 and later married Mary Ruth Morris in 1945.

Murl Marie Byrd born September 12, 1902 and married F. L. Arnot in May 1926.

Georgia Helen Byrd born June 22, 1904 and died in Oklahoma City August 30, 1949. She married Frank Stockton in 1930 and then Benjamin Krass in 1939.

Dorothy Katherine Byrd was born August 17, 1912 in Edmond, Oklahoma and still (1992) lives in Oklahoma City. She married Edward Cox January 14, 1931 and they had one child:

Madison Dekalb Putman Jr.

Madison Junior or *Cal* was born in Alabama on December 15, 1841. He enlisted in the Texas Frontier Cavalry (Confederate Army) during the Civil War on February 20, 1862. He served for three years at Camp San Saba. This regiment served only in the State and was not in conflict with the Union Army. It was a '*compromise arrangement*' for those opposed to the Confederacy.

He married Louisa Jane Casner in Llano County in 1866. She was a daughter of Martin M. Casner and Louisa Jane Medford and was born in Travis County Texas on September 20, 1845. Their first child was born in Llano County in 1867 and was named California or *Callie*. Soon afterward, he led a wagon train to California and settled north of the Mexican border in Julian, San Diego County.

Their next child, John, was born in Hatfield Creek, San Diego County California in 1869.

Madison and his family remained in San Diego County and he died there in San Marcos, San Diego County on February 3, 1915. Louisa had died in Julian, California on February 18, 1906. Both are buried in Ballena, San Diego County California.

Their children were:

CALIFORNIA CORDELIA PUTMAN. She was born July 27, 1867 in Texas. She married Theodore Ulrich on August 15, 1894.

JOHN EDWARD PUTMAN. He was born in Hatfield Creek, California on June 9, 1869. He married Myrtle Bell Bay on May 5, 1895 in Perris, Riverside County California. He was a miner, a farmer and a barber. He died in San Diego on December 30, 1948.

MARTIN M. PUTMAN. He was born May 25, 1872. He died at age 15 on February 7,

1888.

JAMES RANDOLPH PUTMAN. He was born March 6, 1874. He married Mildred L. Parsons in 1898. He died in California in March 1933.

DAVID FRANKLIN PUTMAN. He was born January 15, 1876. He was married to Magdaline Mendival in Santa Cruz County Arizona in 1920. He moved later to San Diego California near his folks. He died there August 5, 1931.

HARVEY DEKALB PUTMAN. He was born April 12, 1886. He married Deltah Billingsley on June 2, 1907 in Ramona, California. He died in Stockton, California on May 4, 1963.

Martha Emaline Putman

Martha was born in Randolph County Alabama on October 10, 1843. She was the last child born before the trip to Texas.

She married William Carrol Billingsley and in 1872, they moved by train, stage and ship to California to be with her brother Madison. William was born in Tennessee in about 1830. She lived in Ramona and Santa Isabel, California.

Here they owned vast orchards of fruit trees and William also was a Justice of the Peace.

William died in Ballena, San Diego County in 1911. She died in Ballena Valley, San Diego County California in 1923.

Their only child was:

MARTHA OLIVIA BILLINGSLEY. She was born on May 30, 1868 in Llano, Texas and lived in California. She married Zaccheus Quincey in Ballena on December 23, 1886. He was born in England in about 1860 and came to America in 1871 at age 11. She died there in 1945. Their children were:

Naomi Effimeline Quincey born January 18, 1888 and died in Los Angeles May 14, 1971.

Amelia Olivia Quincey born January 4, 1889 and died in Los Angeles County April 4, 1982. She married Ralph Greenwood. He was born in Vermont August 14, 1888 and died in Napa June 29, 1953.

William Zacchia Quincey born December 5, 1891.

Evangeline Elizabeth Quincey born April 21, 1893 and married to Cecil Howard.

William Harve Putman

William was born October 9, 1848 in Williamson County Texas. He was married twice. First he married Harriet Caroline 'Hattie' Teague on November 7, 1874. She was born in Alabama March 14, 1856. She was the mother of all four of their children, and she died August 6, 1894 in Texas. William then married Annie Teague December 22, 1896. She was Hattie's sister and the widow of John Barnes Applewhite.

He ranched not only with his father, but owned the adjacent ranch. He may also have been a Texas Ranger.

He died in Llano County on April 9, 1914. All the children were by his first wife, Hattie. Annie was born in March of 1858 and died in the 1920s.

CARRIE PUTMAN. She was born August 7, 1875 and married James O. Wycoff in 1897. He was born in 1867 and had 2 sons from a previous Marriage born in 1890 and 1891. They never had any children of their own. Carrie died in the 1920s and James was widowed in 1930 living with his son Damon.

MADISON DEKALB PUTMAN. He was born September 9, 1877 and died as a child on March 22, 1882 in New Mexico.

WILLIE HATTIE PUTMAN. She was born April 8, 1881 and married Jim C. Jeffries in Llano County on July 19, 1908.

RUBY MAE PUTMAN. She was born March 2, 1882 and died November 16, 1883.

Rachel Olivia Putman

She was born in Williamson County Texas on March 11, 1851. She married John Houston Billingsley July 26, 1870 and remained in Llano, Texas.

She died March 7, 1930 in Kingsland, Llano County and is buried in the Honey Creek Cemetery there.

CATHERINE BILLINGSLEY. Born August 16, 1873 and died in infancy.

DELTAH LLANO BILLINGSLEY. Born May 11, 1884. She moved to California and married Harvey DeKalb Putman in Ramona, San Diego County on June 2, 1907. She died February 7, 1925 in Segundo, Los Angeles County. The children are listed under Harvey DeKalb Putman elsewhere in this section.

VELMA BILLINGSLEY. Born April 16, 1886. She married James Henry Long and lived at Kingsland, Llano County Texas. Their children were:

'Doc' Putman was born December 15, 1854. He married Adeline Victoria Stone on October 15, 1877. She was a daughter of Reuben Gilmore Stone and Celia Scott. She was born in Llano

County on April 13, 1861.

Doc moved to Laredo, Webb County Texas and was there in 1910 and 1920 and 1930. He died in Laredo, Webb County on May 23, 1936. He was hit by an auto and his chest was caved in. He was 81 years old. Adeline died in Laredo on December 26, 1952.

CAROLINE VELMA PUTMAN born June 23, 1880 and died 3 months shy of age 100 on March 30, 1980 She married Virgil Homer Applewhite about 1905. They had:
