Ed Marshall Putnam sealer of weights and measures of Haverhill, Massachusetts, for the past seven years, former alderman of the Haverhill City Council and a former Haverhill business man, died in the morning at 9 o'clock after a long illness.

Whose work as sealer of weights and measures had received a great deal of commendation throughtout the city and had a large circle of friends.

He was in public eye for a number of years because of his work as sealer of weights and measures and because of his being elected as alderman in 1896. He had mentioned on several occasions for city marshall, prominent men becoming interested in his candidacy for the office because of the energetic manner in which he carried out the duties of his own department. Was also a former meat market proprietor in this city and also a former real estate business man.

Was named office of sealer of weights and measures on November 16, 1919 by the city council.

Was the local agent of the Massachusetts Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, being named to that position in 1923.

Albert Edward Putnam lived during his youth in New York City, Brooklyn and Yonkers, where he was educated in the common schools. He did not go to college, but while still in his teens went into business in Wall Street, becoming, on the 4th of December, 1873, a member of the New York Stock Exchange (for tweny-two years). He continued in business as a banker and stockbroker until his death, at which time he was one of the oldest members of the Stock Exchange. In 1864, he formed a partnership in the banking and brokerage business with his brother-in-law, David M. Morrison, now President of the Washington Trust Company of New York, under the firm name of Morrison and Putnam. Later, both of these men were connected with the brokerage firm of Putnam and Earl, but for some years during the latter part of his life, Mr. Putnam carried on the brokerage business alone. A successful and popular broker, he enjoyed the respect of his fellow members of the New York Stock Exchange, and during his membership he amassed a comfortable fortune.

In 1868, shortly after his marriage, he moved to Spuyten Duyvil, a suburb of New York City, and in 1893 he moved into a house which he had built for himself at 16 West 77th Street, New York, which he occupied until his death. While living at Spuyten Duyvil, he became interested in real estate, purchasing large amounts of land both in Spuyten Duyvil and in the sdjoining town of Kingsbridge, much of which he owned at the time of his death. As he improved the land in Kingsbridge with buildings, it may be said that the erection of a good part of the present town was due to him. He was also interested in Lake Placid, Essex County, New York, a town in the Adirondacks, where he spent several summers, and it was largely due to his efforts that funds were raised for the erection of the Episcopal Church at Lake Placid, called "St. Eustace by the Lakes," although he did not live to see it built. With Mr. John H. Prall of New York City, he purchased in 1894, White Face Mountain, one of the highest peaks in the Adirondacks, with the idea of building a railroad to the summit, similar to that on Mt. Washington, New Hampshire, but he died before this object was accomplished.

At the time of the Civil War he was a member of the 7th Regiment, National Guard, New York, which went to the front at the time of the Battle of Gettysburg. Later he participated in the draft riots in New York City.

He was a man of fine character, noble and generous in disposition, and of high standing in the community in which he lived. Through intermarriages in the family, he bears the distinction of being directly descended from all of the three sons of the original settler, John Putnam.

Eben Putnam was treasurer of the Amador Gold Mining and Milling Company, and of the Bow Ridge Development Company. He was for many years actively engaged in historical and genealogical pursuits. The History of the Putnam Family in England and America, The Putnam Leaflets, and The Putnam Lineage are results of his work during many years devoted to the collection of materials illustrating the history of the Putnam and allied families.

For an extended notice of Mr. Putnam see the Putnam Leaflets, for April-May, 1896, and Lamb's Biographical Dictionary of the United States, volume VI, 1903.

He was educated in private schools in Salem and Cambridge, Massachusetts, and graduated from the Cambridge High and Classical School in 1885, and was admitted to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, but a journey to the West turned his inclinations into another channel. He served as clerk in a stock brokerage house for several years, resigning his position to take charge of the Salem Press in 1890, of which concern he continued as manager until 1894, when he visited England for purposes of historical and genealogical study. After another sojourn in England, he, in 1899, became business manager of The International Monthly of New York and Burlington, with residence in Burlington, Vermont, until 1902, when he resumed his business as publisher in Boston. During all these years since 1890, he edited and published a genealogical magazine, originally established as The Salem Press Historical Genealogical Record, and continued under the title of Putnam's Historical Magazine, The genealogical Quarterly Magazine, and The Genealogical Magazine. He also founded and for three years was associate editor of the Vermont Antiquarian. He was also editor of the genealogist's Note Book (1899), and of the genealogical Bulletin (1893-4).

For several years he was a member of the publication and library committees of the Essex Institute and active in the work of that society, and also served upon the library committee of New England Historic Genealogical Society, and for several years was a member of the Committee on English Research which was instrumental in making it possible to continue the invaluable researches of Henry F. Waters and the publication of the results thereof. He organized Old Salem Chapter, S.A.R., the first local chapter established in Massachusetts, one of the founders and first secretary and register of the Old Planters Society, and of the Governor and Company of the Massachusetts Bay in New England, of which society he was secretary and one of the Council. He was elected president of the American Genealogical Society in 1907. He was elected Lieutenant Governor of the vermont Society of Colonial Wars, having previously served as secretary, and delegate to the National Convention. He was a member of the Salem Light Infantry Veteran Association. He was admitted to Amity Lodge, F.&A.M., 2 September, 1892.

Mr. Putnam has always taken a deep interest in athletics, and in his school days was a member of the Cambridge High School and Cambridge Elevens. During his residence in Boston,

Although interested in politics he never sought nor served in office other than as a member of committees appointed at town meeting. While a resident in Danvers, Massachusetts, he was treasurer of the democratic town committee, but during the past ten years his affiliations have been rather with the Republican party, although by no means a believer in the tariff policy of that party.

Mr. Putnam had contributed largely to the various genealogical magazines with which he had been connected, and to family genealogies, in the complication whereof he had frequently assisted. He edited the Osgood Genealogy, assisted in the preparation of the Converse and Allied Families, especially those parts pertaining to English connections. He compiled and edited the Military and Naval Annals of Danvers. Among his lesser publications was an "Enquiry into the authenticity of the First Meeting House at Salem," a monograph showing that the first meeting house had not only not been preserved, but was a building of ample dimensions and worthy of the first settlers of Salem, Massachusetts, which led to an acrimonious discussion lasting for three years. His contention was eventually throughly endorsed by a competent committee appointed by the Essex Institute.

Although from physical causes obliged to abandon nearly all literary work, his interest in historical matters remains unabated. Since 1903 he had been interested in the development of mining properties in Amador County, Califorina.
