FLEMMING PUTMAN

of Moore County Tennessee

Flemming Putman was a son of Wilson Putman and Rebecca Flemming of Rutherford County, North Carolina. He was born in April 1832 in Morgan County, Alabama.

He married Elizabeth Jenkins on December 27, 1851 in Madison County, Alabama. Elizabeth must have died in the 1860s, as on May 27, 1870 Flemming married Mary L. Kitchner in Franklin County, Tennessee. They were not in the 1880 Soundex.

In 1900 he is in Moore County, Tennessee and is 68, Mary is 68 and he has three grand children, two Marlers and one Clark, at home. He died after 1900 in Moore County, Tennessee.

These are his children:

HENDERSON J. PUTMAN born in September 1852. He was married twice, first to Matilda J. Prince in Bedford County, Tennessee on December 8, 1869 and they had one child. After she died, he married Omi Wilson also in Bedford County, on December 25, 1878. The rest of his children were with her. They then moved to Texas, and the family is in Hardeman County, Texas in 1900. His children were:

John William Putman born in Moore County, Tennessee March 5, 1875. The only child in the first marriage. He married Mattie Shofel about 1901 in Hardeman County, Texas. She died in 1906 and he married a Lillie and was in Kowa County Oklahoma in 1910 through 1930. He died in Comanche County Oklahoma November 8, 1953. Lillie was born in 1874 and died in 1955.

Logan Lewis Putman born in Tennessee in November 1879. He has a wife Mary in 1920 and then died in Hardeman County September 19, 1922.

James Walter Putman born in Tennessee June 23, 1881.

Mary Putman born in Texas in September 1885.

Jessie Putman, a daughter born in Texas in October 1889.

WALTER SCOTT PUTMAN born in August 1854. He was with the family in 1860 and 1870 and married to L. C. Jackson in Franklin County Tennessee in 1880. They were married April 12, 1877. In 1900 he is in Arlington, Tarrant County Texas with the same wife now listed as Palestine. In 1900 they had been married 24 years and all three of the kids are with them.

Victoria Putman born in August 1877. There is a tombstone in Arlington Cemetery for Victoria Putman Lyon 1878-1974. There is also a stone for Richard N. Lyon 1881-1935.

Rufus Estell Putman born July 13, 1879. He is single at home in 1900. In 1910 he is in Arlington listed 32 TN TN TN and owns a blacksmith shop. His wife Mattie is 31 TX TX TX. They have been married 1 year and it is a second marriage for both. I can't find him in 1920, but he is buried in Arlington and his stone reads July 13, 1879 – December 12, 1956. There is also a stone for a Jessie M. Putman 1885-1902 who may have been his first wife. In 1930, he is 'single' in San Diego, California. In 1920 Mattie is in San

Diego though and divorced at the time.

Oliver Putman born in April 1887.

MARTHA PUTMAN born in 1857. There is a marriage record of a M. P. Putman marrying J. C. Clark in Moore County on December 9, 1880. In 1900, a Zula Clark age 18 is living with her grand father Flemming. I guess they both had died by 1900.

NANCY C. PUTMAN born about 1862. She married W. J. Marler on July 8, 1880. She and he must have died by 1900 as Flemming in 1900 had two Marler kids, William 19 and Marsh 18 living with him as grand children.

ELIZABETH E. PUTMAN born about 1864. She married A. A. Clark in Moore County on June 14, 1883. In 1900 there was a Zula Clark, a grand daughter, living with Flemming. Zula was either her daughter or her sister's who married J. C. Clark. Not certain at all.
