OTHER SOUTHERN PUTMAN FAMILIES IN TEXAS

By 1880 several families came from our Hall County, Georgia gang including some of Jacob Putman and Sarah Johnson's children into Comanche County.

Some children of Elias Putman of Hall County, Georgia and Howard Putman of Cleburne County, Alabama came to Cooke County. Others of Howard's family went to Grayson County.

Willis Putman and some of his kids from Hall County, Georgia ended up in McLennan County.

Even some of the elusive family from Jefferson County, Tennessee came to Montague County.

And several of the old North Carolina bunch were in Tarrant County.

Abraham Pinkney Putman from Hall County, Georgia ended up with several sons in Young County.

We find James M. Putman in Navarro County. He is a son of James W. Putman and Elizabeth Guire and was born in Morgan County, Alabama. He is a grandson of Martin and Huldy Putman of Marshall County, Alabama.

We get Joseph Green and Martha Putman from Greene County, Missouri with their kids in Parker County. Also in Parker County, we get Elijah Putman from DeKalb County, Alabama.

It goes on and on.

By 1900 it gets rather numerous. There were all sorts of Putmans of our line in Texas. I suppose I should not be surprised as it is a huge State after all.
