DAVID PATTERSON of Callaway County Missouri

David Patterson was the only child of John Patterson's second marriage with Sally Hubbard Jameson.

He was born in St. Louis County on June 17, 1812.

He was married twice. First to Susan Houser on October 19, 1837. Susan was born in Kentucky in 1819 and she died on August 5, 1852. Susan is buried in Coldwater Cemetery.

He then married Sarah Bright on August 21, 1861. Sarah was a daughter of Michael Bright and Sarah 'Sally' Price.

He moved to Callaway County, Missouri. Maybe he moved before this second marriage. I do not know.

David Patterson died in Callaway County, Missouri on October 27, 1892.

He had five children by the first marriage: Charles, Rachel, Talton, Milton and Marshall. By the second marriage he had one son, Price Bright Patterson.

Charles H. Patterson

Charles was born in St. Louis County on June 30, 1837. He married Margaret 'Maggie' McClintoc December 12, 1883. Maggie was a sister of his brother Milton Patterson's wife Nannie. Both were daughters of Moses and Mary McClintic or McClintock. They remained in Callaway County. Charles died there June 2, 1891 and Maggie April 26, 1901.

They had one child that lived:

CHARLES JOSEPH PATTERSON born April 27, 1891. He married Jane Elizabeth Carroll in Fayette Missouri November 28, 1911. He died in California in 1939. Jane was born September 20, 1891 and died in Los Angeles September 20, 1891. They had one child:

Charles Orace Patterson born October 31, 1912 and died in Pasadena February 20, 1949. He married Evelyn Bruns and they had two children: Charles Elmer and Sheila Patterson.

Rachel E. Patterson

Rachel was born September 27, 1842 in Callaway County.

She married Walter Ayers Robinson in Callaway County on February 8, 1865. This was Walter's

second marriage. Walter was born June 10, 1829 and died April 22, 1893.

Rachel was listed in the 1880, 1900 and 1910 census of Callaway County. She died December 6, 1931.

Their children were:

SUSAN E. ROBINSON born November 21, 1865. She never married and died March 5, 1937.

MARSHALL ROBINSON born in 1866 and died in infancy.

JOHN W. ROBINSON born September 20, 1868 and died August 5, 1840. He was never married.

CHARLES A. ROBINSON born January 5, 1870. He was living with his brother John in 1900. He married, but I do not know to whom. He died February 9, 1940.

MARY BELLE ROBINSON born December 21, 1871. She married Walter Bell Wallace and died in childbirth on July 8, 1897.

DAVID ROBINSON born January 27, 1874 and died in 1876.

WALTER M. ROBINSON born October 1877. He was still with his mother in 1900.

MILTON ROBINSON born November 12, 1880. He died May 9, 1950. I do not think he married.

SARAH PRICE ROBINSON was born March 19, 1882. She married Irving William Holman. She died October 23, 1970. Their three children were:

Rachel Elizabeth Holman who married a Matthew.

Harold Robinson Holman born October 26, 1910 and died June 30, 1956 in a TWA airplane crash in the Grand Canyon.

Sarah Ruth Holman

ENNIS V. ROBINSON born April 14, 1886. His wife was Myrtle McClintock. They lived in McCredie, Missouri where he died April 20, 1968. Myrtle was born February 12, 1890 and died December 4, 1972 in Fulton, Missouri. Their children were:

Dean Ennis Robinson born December 22, 1919.

Rita Rachel Robinson born March 24, 1922 and married to Jesse Stephens on September 26, 1940 in Columbia, Missouri. Jesse was born March 17, 1919. They had two children.

Talton K. Patterson

Talton Patterson was born in St. Louis County on June 17, 1846. He married Laura Elizabeth McAmay or McKamie in Callaway County on January 30, 1868.

Talton died there on March 3, 1931 and is buried in Westminster Cemetery in Fulton, Callaway County, Missouri.

Their children were:

LAURA P. PATTERSON born in 1871. She married a Moore.

WILLIAM PATTERSON born in 1869

JAMES PATTERSON born in 1878

MAE P. PATTERSON who married a Stevens.

Milton H. Patterson

Milton was born in 1849. He married Mary 'Nannie' McClintock in Callaway County. Mary was a sister of Charles Patterson's wife Margaret. Both were daughters of Moses and Mary McClintock or McClintock. I have information on two children:

MELVIN PATTERSON

Marshall Patterson

Marshall Patterson was the last child in the first marriage. He was born in 1852.

He moved to Callaway County and married, but I do not have his wife's name. They had two daughters:

SUSAN ELIZABETH PATTERSON who married a Platt.

RACHEL JEANETTE PATTERSON who married a Walters.

Price Bright Patterson

Price was the only child in the second marriage between David Patterson and Sarah Bright. He was named for her two ancestral lines.

Price was born about 1863 in Callaway County, Missouri.

I do not know any more about this son or his family, if any.
